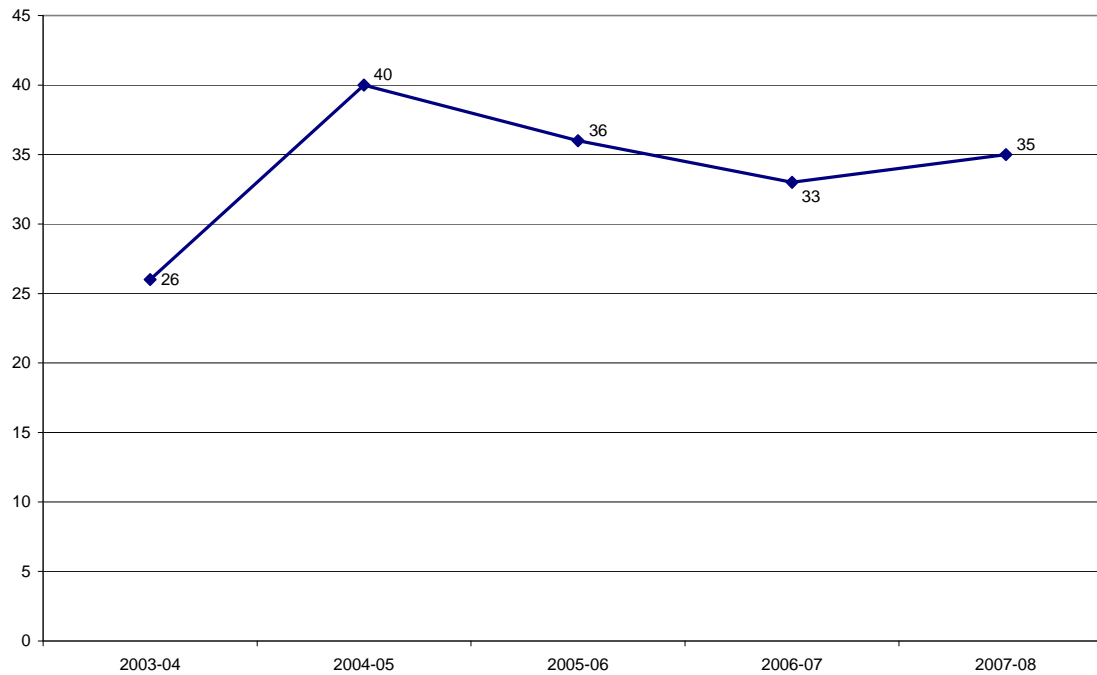

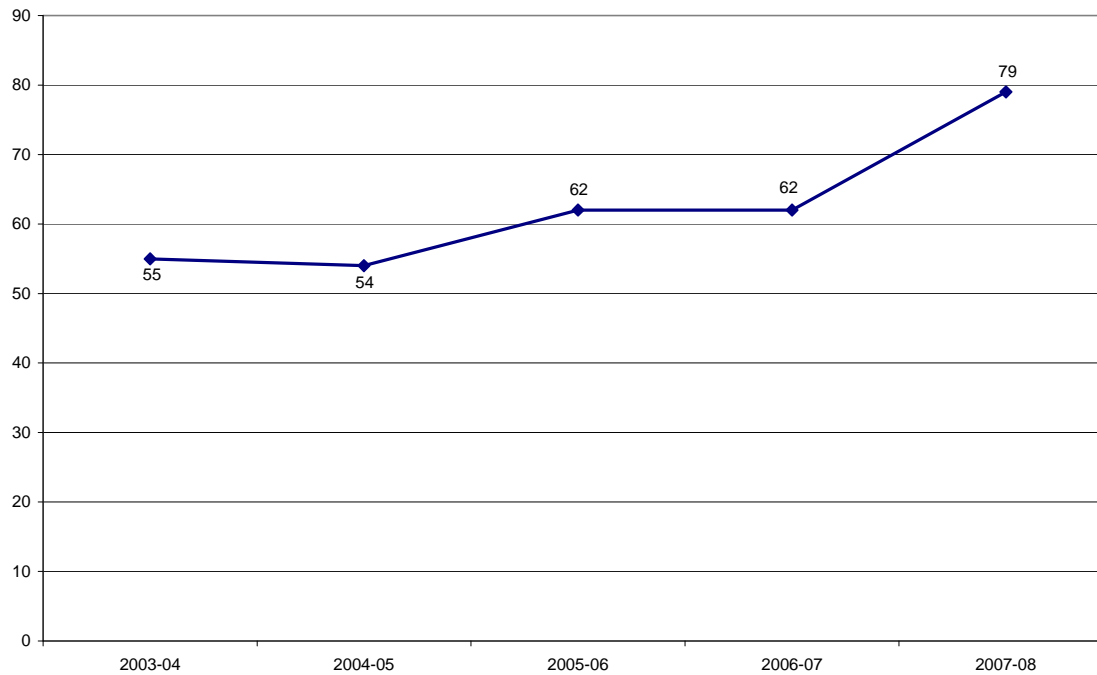

Annual FTES - Allied Health



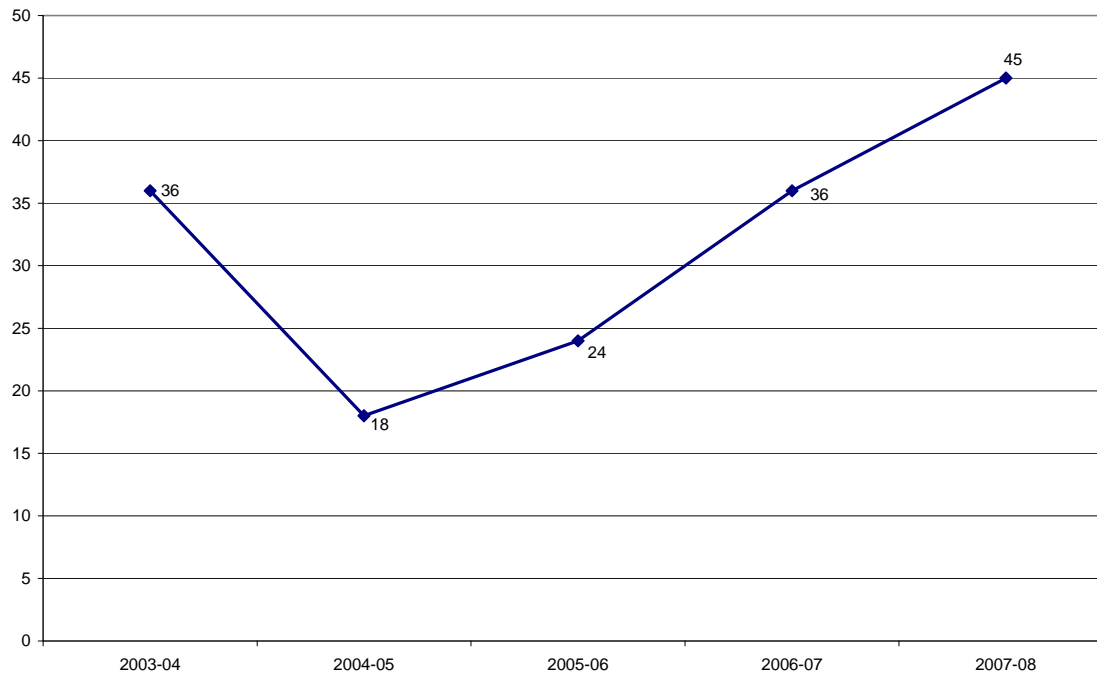

Annual FTES - Consumer Family Sciences



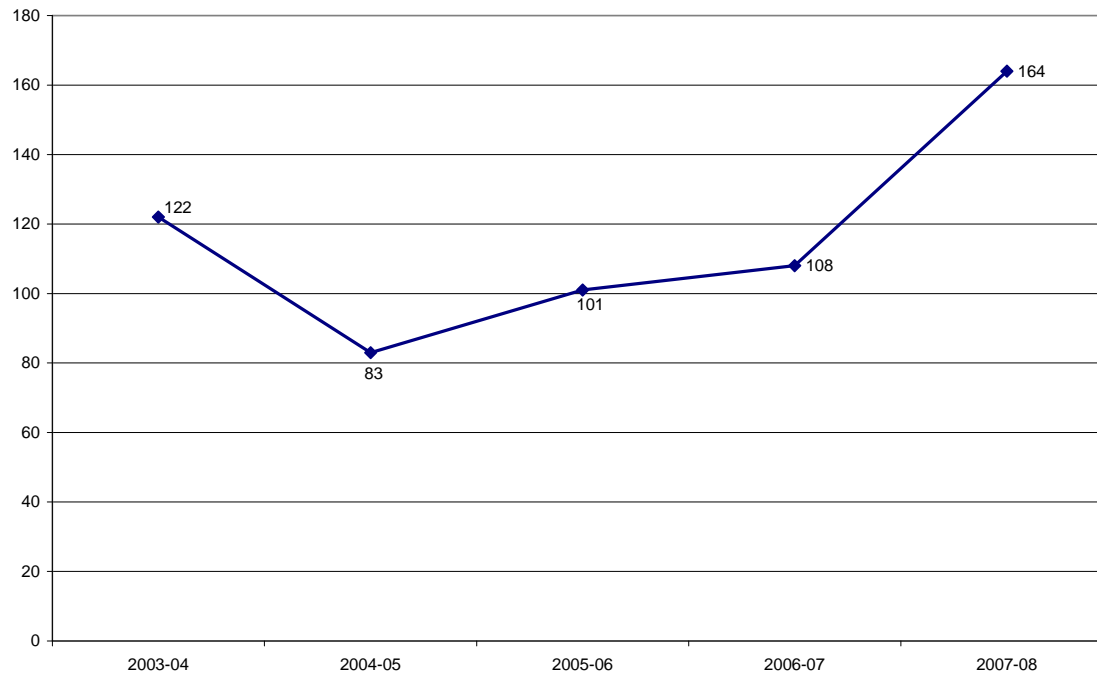
# FTES: Physical Therapist Assistant

Annual FTES - Physical Therapist Assistant



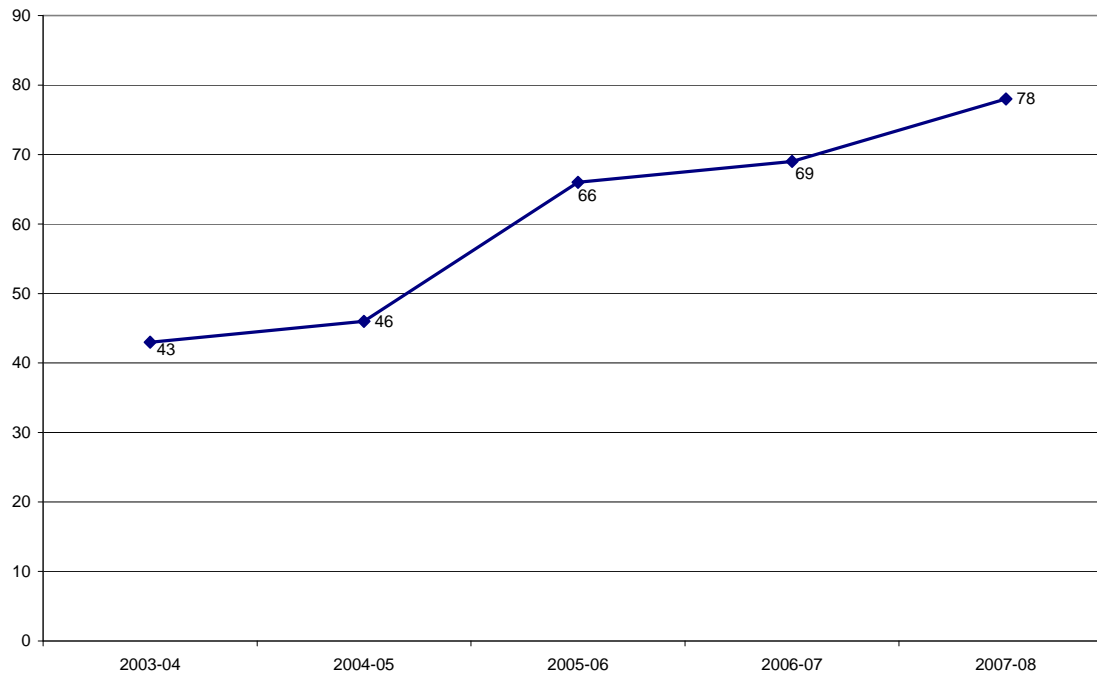

Annual FTES - Nursing

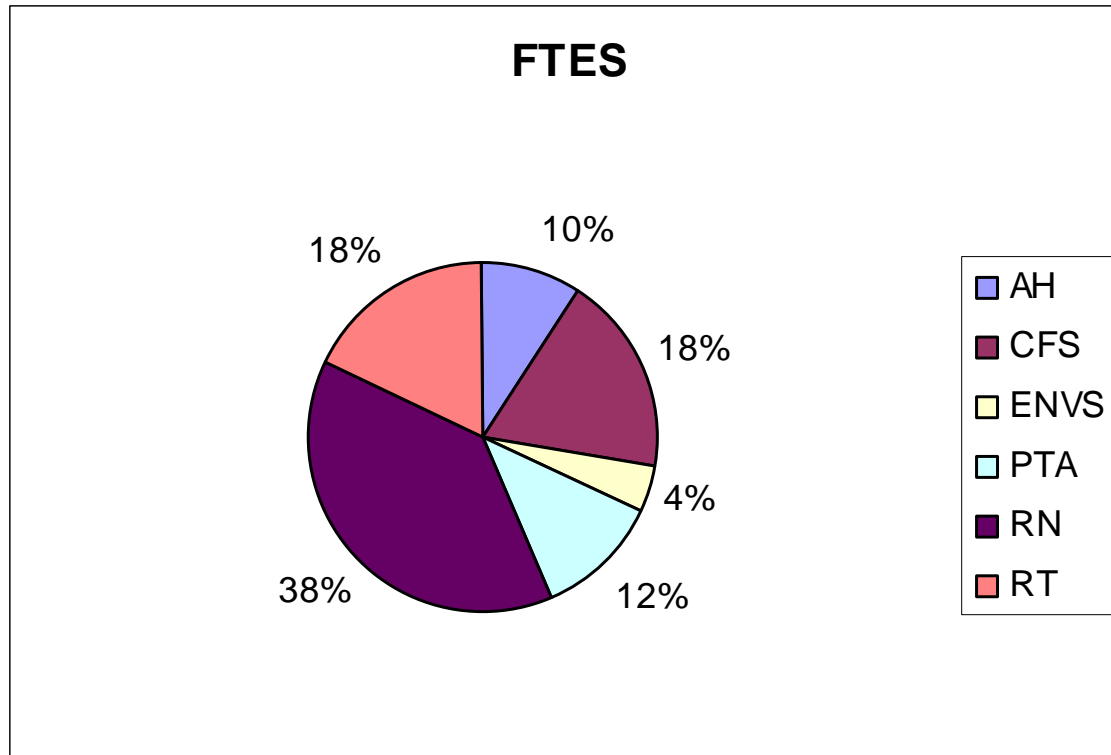


# FTES: Respiratory Therapist

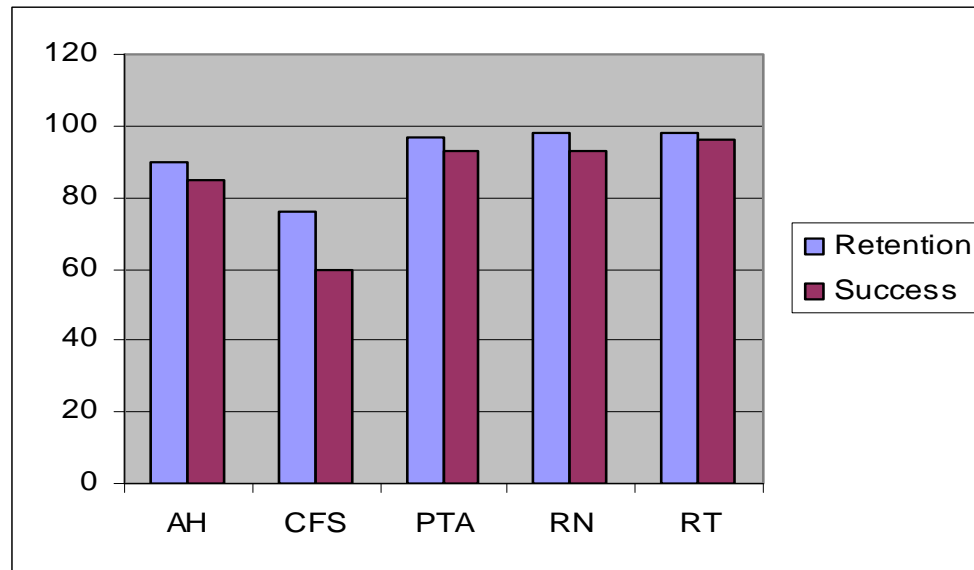
Annual FTES - Respiratory Therapy

# Grants
