

11. the buildings to the north of Bldg. #2 will be removed, and replaced with parking as sited in #10.
12. every effort will be made through building design and other landscape changes to make our campus in compliance with current Universal Design Concepts as they relate to access, and an ecologically and environmentally stable and efficient area. It is our hope that continuing efforts are explored for the use of alternative energy sources.
13. the current positioning of the baseball/softball fields will remain, with the possibility that a move may be made, in consultation with the P.E. Department, in order to gain closer parking access, or a partnership develops which may finance construction on that site.
14. ongoing exploration of alternative funding for additional/enhanced parking facilities.

There is ongoing concern by members of the College community regarding the timeline for construction and plans for the continued, and minimal interruption of the business of the College. We would hope that any plans and/or timelines would consider the instructional processes at the College of paramount importance, and every effort be made to assure the continuity of this mission. We would further request that there be a regular reporting interval to the College community ("construction" web page, President's Forums, weekly updates in the Monitor/Argus, reports to the College Council, display in the library, and other appropriate venues) regarding the developing plans for the Fremont campus.
