## ADMISSION INSTRUCTIONS FOR K-9<sup>th</sup> GRADE STUDENTS

 **Deadline for permission packets: Monday, August 7, 2017 (No Exceptions)**

 **Registration: Monday, August 28, 2017**

Admission for students who have not yet completed the 9<sup>th</sup> grade is approved **only** in exceptional cases for enrollment and in the courses listed below, **provided they meet all prerequisites**. Carefully follow these instructions to avoid processing delays.

### ENROLLMENT STEPS

**STEP 1:** Submit these three forms together and in person at the Office of Admissions and Records:

**Application for Admission:** Log into or create an [OpenCCCApply](#) account and complete an online application to Ohlone College. You will not be allowed to register without a current application on file.

**Exceptional Student Form** must include the teacher's recommendation and signatures of the student, parent, and principal. Any missing signatures will delay registration.

**Parent/Guardian Health Center Authorization Form for Minors (Medical Waiver)**

**Immigration documents for non-United States citizens:** Please click the link and fill out the [Immigration and Residency form](#) if you are not a United States citizen. You must provide a copy of your high school identification card and your permanent resident card, Visa, or I-797. Missing documentation will delay registration.

#### STEP 2: Register for Classes

K-9<sup>th</sup> grade students who have been admitted for FALL 2017 and given an Ohlone College Student ID number may register online via [WebAdvisor](#) beginning on the first day of classes, Monday, August 28. K-9<sup>th</sup> grade students must attend the first class meeting and obtain an Add Authorization Code from the instructor **before** registering via WebAdvisor. K-9<sup>th</sup> grade students must be approved for admission before attending the first class meeting.

### GENERAL INFORMATION FOR K-12<sup>th</sup> GRADE STUDENTS

In accordance with Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations, K-12<sup>th</sup> grade students may enroll as special part-time students while they maintain their regular school attendance. Units earned may be used for high school credit and college credit. **There is a seven (7.0) unit maximum for K-12<sup>th</sup> grade students during the fall semester.**

Enrolling in classes at Ohlone College is the first step in a college career. K-12<sup>th</sup> grade students are expected to participate at the college level. Class materials and content may include adult language and subject material. **Grades received at Ohlone College become part of a PERMANENT college record and transcript.** Students should make class selections very carefully with parent, school, counselor, and principal guidance.

Multiple signatures are required on the **School Permission Form for 10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade Students**. It is advisable to begin this process **at least four weeks** prior to the end of the student's current school term.

K-12<sup>th</sup> grade students attending during the fall semester are exempt from paying the California Community College Enrollment Fee (\$46 per unit), but are subject to a \$19 Health Services fee, a \$5 Online Registration Access Fee, and a \$5.00 optional Student Activities Fee for on-campus classes.

## Parent/Guardian Authorization Form for Minors

Be advised that a physician supervises this clinic and that a nurse practitioner is on duty during the fall and spring semesters from 9:00 am – 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm Monday through Thursday. Summer hours are Monday through Thursday 10:00 am – 2:00 pm and 4:00 pm – 6:00 pm.

The nurse practitioner is available for acute care (sore throats, sprained ankles, etc.) and emergency care (accidents), and over the counter medicines such as Tylenol, Advil as needed. This authorization will permit your minor child to avail themselves to these services. As a parent/guardian you are welcome to call (510) 656-6258 to discuss these services. Providers are bound by confidentiality regulations even if students are minors.
