Why do you need to declare a major?

To be awarded an associate degree, certificate of achievement or certificate of completion (also sometimes referred to as a fast-track certificate), you must have a declared academic program. These awards are acknowledged on your transcript for use by educational institutions, employers, prospective employers, and various government agencies and departments.

Priority dates and times for registration are sooner for students with a declared major.
