We are respectfully requesting that Associated Students of Ohlone College, (ASOC) replace round tables to the Ohlone College cafeteria for student use.

As representatives of Ohlone College and the Deaf Studies student body, we are concerned with supporting the needs of the Deaf. Round tables provide individuals with a wider field of vision to facilitate visual communication; linear tables do not.

The ASL club supports the mission of the ASOC to represent the student's needs, wants and concerns. The ASOC has been instrumental in supporting the social matrix of Ohlone College, which in turn supports a collegial and learning environment. The cafeteria has served not only as an eating and meeting space, but also as a community center, where students gather to share and express ideas. We are grateful to the ASOC's efforts to upkeep the cafeteria.


Recent renovations have been welcome and appreciated, except for the removal of the round tables, which were consistently used by Deaf students. Deaf students seated at round tables are able to communicate effectively with a greater number of people. The shape of the table is integral to our meetings and social gatherings.

The purchase of new round tables to match the new linear tables in the cafeteria would be a strong expression of the ASOC's desire to support the needs of all students, including those of the Deaf and hard of hearing. As such, your gesture would align closely with the mission of the ASL Club to uphold freedom of expression and support of all people.






