Ohlone bats slug out 9 runs in the 6th for the victory

REDWOOD CITY, CA- The Ohlone College Renegades Baseball team (6-8) defeated the Canada College Colts (10-2) by the score of 12-4. Ohlone pitcher Joe Gardner (2-2) struck out 6 batters in 6 innings while only allowing 1 earned run on way to earning his 2nd decision of the season. Freshman Brian Klimenko took the loss for Canada.

David Luna led the way for the Renegades going 2-5 with a pair of Home runs, one being a Grand Slam, and both being in the 6th inning to lift the Ohlone offense. Luna finished the day with 6 RBI. Sophomore outfielder Andrew Ham set the table for Ohlone all afternoon going 4-5 with 4 singles and an RBI. Matt Langseth, Braxton Miller, Michael Vandebusch and Zach Townsend all had 2 hit games. While Justin Lunday was 1-4 with a 2B and an RBI. *“Our Offense really took good approaches all day against their pitchers,” said Head Coach Tom Kunis. “They swung in good counts and really battled when faced with 2 strikes”.*



Ohlone’s defense, which had been off and on the past few games, really came alive in this afternoon. The Renegades turned 2 double plays and had some incredible diving catches to rob hits from the Canada batters. *“Our Team did a fantastic job of playing pitch-to-pitch baseball”, explained Kunis. “It was a complete team effort, from the guys in the field, to the players in the dugout, to our coaching staff; everyone was on the same page”.*

Ohlone finishes the pre-season (6-8) with 3 rain-out games still to be played at later dates. The Renegades open the start of Coast Conference-South play this Thursday at Gavilan College game time is set for 2:00pm. RHP Shane Murchison (3-1) is set to take the hill for the Renegades.
