

Ohlone Bats Secure 15-12 Win

Renegades Slug out 20 Hits against San Jose City College

FREMONT, CA – The Ohlone offense came ready to play Saturday afternoon at Pal Field in San Jose. The Renegades (9-10) defeated San Jose City College by the score of 15-12 on a very windy day.



Ohlone pitchers combined for 9 strikeouts on the afternoon. Joe Gardner (2-3) started the game and left with the lead, but San Jose city would retake the lead and reliever David Luna (1-0) would earn the win for Ohlone. Closer Kurtis Sherer would pick up the save for Ohlone his 3rd of the season.

Ohlone's offense was lead by Rich McDowell who went 4-5 with 2 doubles, a triple, and a Grand Slam HR that was the go ahead runs in the ball game. On the day McDowell had 7 RBI.

"Rich has really come on for us in conference", said Head Coach Tom Kunis. "He is seeing the ball real well."

Matt Langseth was 3-4 in the game with a walk, a double, 2 singles and 2 RBI. DH David Luna was also 3-4 on the afternoon with 2 RBI, and Outfielder Andrew Ham was 2-4 with 2 runs batted in.

"Our offense really came ready to play to", said Kunis. "Any time you get 20 hits in a ball game you have to be pleased with the effort and concentration."
