

OHLONE Baseball Takes Convincing Win Over Monterey 9-0

Krisman throws a complete game shutout in the victory

Monterey, CA- The Ohlone College Renegades (10-12) defeated Monterey Peninsula College 9-0 on a wet and rainy Saturday afternoon.



Freshman pitcher Cory Krisman earned his 1st college victory in convincing fashion as the right hander gave up only 4 hits, while striking out 6 in 9 innings of work, earning the shutout.

-Justin Lunday was 2-5 with 2 RBI

Ohlone jumped ahead early in the second inning as catcher David Luna hit his 4th HR of the season over the leftfield wall giving the Renegades a 1-0 lead. Nick Caravelli would then hit a double and advance to third on a groundball. Caravelli would score on a misplayed run down by Monterey, extending the lead 2-0. After a successful shutdown inning by Krisman in the bottom of the second inning, Ohlone's offense struck again. After three consecutive singles by Drew Ham, Rich McDowell and Matt Langseth, Justin Lunday drove home Ham on a long sac fly to center field. Then Designated Hitter Braxton Miller took the first pitch curveball over the leftfield fence for a 3-run Homerun giving the Renegades a 6-0 lead. The shot was Miller's 3rd round tripper of the season.

Ohlone would extend the lead in the 5th inning on a line drive by Rich McDowell that would score Zach Townsend from second base making it 7-0 Ohlone. On the mound Krisman kept Monterey hitters off balance all afternoon locating his off speed pitches, as well as spotting his fastball.

"Cory showed me a lot today", said Head Coach Tom Kunis. To pitch a complete game shutout, as well as keep his pitch count down was impressive."

The Renegades would score again in the 6th inning on a Justin Lunday single to left field scoring Drew Ham, and Matt Langseth making the score 9-0. That would be all that Krisman would need as he held the Monterey batters to just 2 hits through the next three innings to secure the victory. Ohlone had 16 hits on the afternoon, and was led by David Luna who was 2-5 with 2-RBI, and Braxton Miller who went 1-4 with 3-RBI. Drew Ham and Rich McDowell continued to swing the bat well both having 3 hits on the day for Ohlone. 1st baseman Justin Lunday and Third baseman Nick Caravelli were both 2-5, while Matt Langseth was 2-4 with an RBI and a stolen base.

Langseth has hit safely in 18 out of Ohlone's 22 games this season. Ohlone looks to use this win as momentum into their "Spring Break Invitational Tournament" this upcoming Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. Ohlone is set to play Taft College on Monday at Ohlone. The game time is set for 2:00pm.
