

# OHLONE Defeats Monterey 6-2

*Clutch Hitting & Pitching proves to be the difference for Ohlone*

**Fremont, CA-** Ohlone College got the lift that they needed on the strong pitching performance of Joe Gardner (3-4) to give Ohlone College (13-14) a 6-2 victory over visiting Monterey Peninsula College (15-13) on Thursday afternoon.

Joe Gardner pitched very well for Ohlone striking out 7 of Monterey's hitters while walking 0 in 7 innings of work. Gardner also only gave up 5 hits on the day.

*"This was one of Joe's better outings on the season", said head Coach Tom Kunis. "He really attacked hitters down in the zone, and was able to locate his secondary pitches effectively."*

## Aaron Chavez went 1-3 with 2RBI

The losing pitcher for Monterey was James Legsay (2-3) gave up 5 hits, but also walked 3 Ohlone batters and Hit 2 batters that led to big innings for Ohlone.

Ohlone's offense was spread out through a number of Renegade batters Matt Langseth was 1-4 with a 2B and a stolen base. Michael Vandebusch had an RBI 2B going 1-3 on the afternoon as well as a hit by pitch, and a stolen base. Sophomore Justin Lunday who had the day off came of the bench late in the game for a pitch hit 1B and RBI for the Renegades. Catcher Braxton Miller was 1-2 with 2B, a hit by pitch, and a walk. Ohlone also got a lift from centerfielder Aaron Chavez who went 1-3 with a 1B and 2 RBI.

*"Our offense scored when we needed then to", said Coach Kunis. "I will take less hits as a team if that means we get the "W"."*

Ohlone breaks a 2 game losing skid with the win and evens there conference record in the Coast-South to (5-5-3<sup>rd</sup> Place). Ohlone Baseball looks to continue the winning as they host City College of San Francisco next Tuesday in Fremont. Game time is set for 2:00pm
