

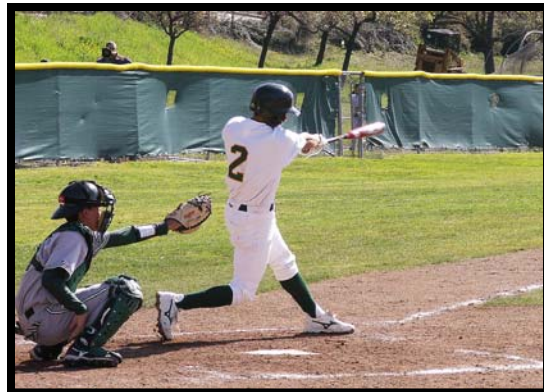
RENEGADES Baseball Explodes for 31 runs in Win!

Ohlone knocks out 30 hits in 31-11 win over Gavilan

GILROY, CA – The Ohlone College baseball team exploded for 31 runs on 30 hits in a Conference win over Gavilan College on a windy Saturday afternoon. Starter David Luna (3-1) earned the victory for Ohlone throwing 4 innings and only allowing 2 earned runs.

Ohlone got things going in the 1st inning as Justin Lunday hit a hard single threw the infield to score Matt Langseth and give Ohlone the early 1-0 lead. Ohlone would follow up in the 2nd inning breaking out for 5 runs off the bats of Aaron Chavez, David Luna, and Justin Lunday who all had RBI hits in the inning.



Gavilan answered back in the 4th inning as they put up 5 runs on 4 hits and closed the lead 6-5.

All was quiet until the Ohlone 7th inning. That is when the renegades broke the game open. Third baseman Nick Caravelli opened the inning off with a double and then stole third base. Caravelli would score on an RBI sac-fly by Aaron Chavez to make it 7-5. Langseth would single next, and 2 Gavilan errors would load the bases for Ohlone. Braxton Miller was hit by the next pitch that scored a run. The very next pitch Rich McDowell hit a double to right centerfield scoring 2 runs. Drew Ham came up next and hit an RBI single to right field. After 3 more hit batsmen and 2 walks Caravelli would come around to hit again, and hit an RBI 1B to leftfield. After the Caravelli hit there were 2 more hit batsmen and a walk. That plated Rich McDowell who again got an RBI hit to right field. The Ohlone Renegades batted around three times and plated Nick Caravelli for third time in the inning. Caravelli hit his first Career Grand Slam giving him three hits and 5 RBI in the inning. Ohlone would finish the 7th inning with 17 runs, 12 hits making the score 23-5.

Ohlone would get some solid relief pitching from Mike Annino who threw 2 innings allowing 0 runs. Ohlone would also use Sean Henning, Cole Campana, and Cory Krisman in relief. The 3 pitchers combined for 4 strikeouts.

In the 8th inning freshman David Keller got his 1st career hit as he pitch hit to lead off the Ohlone 8th. Justin Lunday would follow up with another single. After a Braxton miller walk, Kevin Sherer would pick up an RBI on a hard hit ground ball to the shortstop making the score 29-7.

In the 9th inning Ryan Harmon hit a pitch hit single, and was plated by Chris Doble who hit his 1st career Homerun, that made the score 31-8. Gavilan would put up three runs in the 9th inning on a Evan Jacobs double to make the score 31-11 but that would be all as Ohlone secured their 11th conference win of the season.

Nick Caravelli went 3-4 with 5 RBI including a Grand Slam, 2B, 1B. Andrew ham, and Aaron Chavez both had 2 hits apiece with 3 RBI. Other Renegades who contributed in the win were Kevin Sherer who was 3-7 with 3 RBI Zack Townsend who had 2 hits, and Braxton Miller and David Luna who both had RBI 2B's on the day.

Ohlone will look to keep their playoff hope alive as they face Skyline College on Tuesday in Pacifica. Skyline is currently ranked in the top 10 in Northern California, and sits in a 2 way tie for first place of the Coast Conference- North Division. Game time is set for 2:00pm
