

Luna gets first win as Renegades defeat West Valley College

Offense Scores 12 runs in the Victory

Fremont, CA- David Luna entered Thursday's series opener against West Valley knowing that he had to pitch a better game than he did a week ago against Diablo Valley College. Luna set out to do better Thursday, and he did just that pitching a strong six innings, allowing one run on four hits with four strikeouts in Ohlone's 12-6 win Thursday.



"I really had my pitches working today," Luna said after the game. "I felt like I was able to mix pretty well against their hitters"

"David threw very well this afternoon, and showed a lot of poise," said Head Coach Jordon Twohig about his veteran pitcher.

The Renegade offense also gave Luna some security as they were able to score 12 runs on 13 hits. Outfielder Steven Ramos started the first inning with a walk and would eventually score off a Zack Johnson RBI to begin the Renegades scoring for Ohlone. The big hit came today from designated hitter Jeff Johnson, who had a 2-RBI 2B in the right-center gap in the fifth inning to give Luna some added insurance runs.

"It's always easier to pitch with a lead," Luna added about the Ohlone offense. "Hats off to our guy's for getting the momentum in the first inning and holding onto it through the game".

With the 12-runs scored, this marks the second straight game Ohlone has put up double digit scores.

"The run support is great to see early on, but we feel strongly that our pitching and defense is what will have to rely on to compete in the Coast Conference this season, said Coach Twohig".

Ohlone returns to action tomorrow at Renegade Field at Ohlone College for game-2 against the West valley Vikings. Freshman Sean Martin (1-0) gets the start for the Renegades. Game time is set for 1:30pm
