

OHLONE Baseball Takes the Series on the Shoulders of Martin

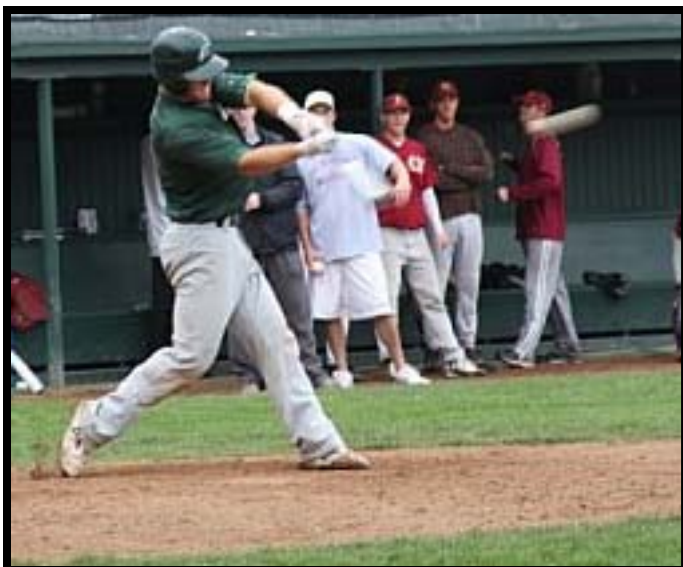
Sean Martin moves to (2-0) on the season

FREMONT, CA- Freshman starting pitcher Sean Martin improves to (2-0) on the season after throwing 7 strong innings on Saturday against West Valley in the 3-0 win. Martin had 2 strikeouts and only 1 walk in the outing.

Ohlone's offense was paced by three-hitter Zach Johnson who was 3-4 with an RBI and four-hitter Braxton Miller who was also 3-4 with 2-2B and 2 RBI. The three combined RBI's would be the only runs scored by both club's all day. "Both Brax and Z.J. are swinging the bats well, and are taking what the pitcher gives them," said Head baseball coach Jordon Twohig. "It is always nice when you get good run production out of your 3,4 spots in the line-up."

West Valley looked to regain momentum in the 5th inning as they were able to load the bases with 0 out on Ohlone. The Renegades would find a way to get out of the threat as shortstop Aaron Chavez caught a line drive and back picked the runner at 2nd base who did not tag for a double play. Martin then was able to pop up the next hitter in the infield to end the inning and maintain the lead. "I was very proud of the way Sean held his cool on the mound," commented Coach Twohig. "He battled out of some tough situations."



With the shutout Ohlone moves to (5-2) on the year. West valley drops to (1-6) on the year. The two clubs will meet for the third and final game of the series Sunday at Renegade Field at Ohlone College. Game time is set for 11:00am. Sophomore Alex Oberle looks to get the start for Ohlone.
