



OFFENSE EXPLODES FOR 18 RUNS AT HOME

Ussery goes 3-5 with 3 RBI

FREMONT, CA- The Ohlone College Renegades (10-3) took game one of a three game series against De Anza College on Thursday by a score of 18-6. David Luna earned his 3rd win of the year (3-0) going 5 innings, striking out 6 Don Batters, and giving up only 1 hit.

The story of the day was the Renegades offense. Ohlone got the ball rolling early in the 1st Inning as Steve Ramos lead off with a double down the left field line and then later scored on a Zack Johnson single. With 2 outs, Aaron Plimmer (Dublin High) then doubled to the left-center gap scoring Johnson. Brad Reeves and Michael Ussery (Newark Memorial High) followed with doubles of their own and the route was on.

Ohlone added 7 more runs in the 2nd inning, 2 in the 4th, 1 in the 6th, and finished their scoring with 4 in the 7th. On the day the Renegades pounded out 21 hits, 8 of which were for extra bases. Aaron Plimmer finished the day going 2 for 3 with 2 doubles and 2 runs scored. Michael Ussery went 3 for 5 with a double and a triple, 3 RBI's, and 3 runs scored.

The Renegades look to continue their hot bats tomorrow when they head to Cupertino, Ca to play game 2 of their 3 game set against the Dons of De Anza. Cory Krisman will get his first start of the year for the Renegades.
