CUPERTINO, CA- Cory Krisman garnered his first win of the year and Ian Hoff received his 3rd save of the year as the Ohlone Renegades (11-3) won on the road by a score of 4-3.

Cory Krisman gave the Renegades a big boost on the bump as he struck out 9 De Anza batters while pitching 6 strong innings, giving up only 2 hits, and 2 unearned runs. Ian Hoff continued his solid pitching by throwing the final 3 innings of the contest allowing only 3 hits, 1 earned run, and struck out 2 batters.

Offensively, the Renegades were lead by the Johnson brothers. Zack Johnson gave the Ohlone their first run of the day when he knocked in Steven Ramos with a ground out in the top of the 1st inning. Jeff Johnson then followed with a mammoth blast that cleared the left field fence for his 3rd homerun of the year.

This game would be decided in the bottom of the 9th. The Dons lead off the inning with 2 singles and had runners at 2nd and 3rd after a groundout to short. Ian Hoff then received another groundout to Aaron Chavez at short and that set the table for the dramatic ending. With 2 on and 2 out Leonard Perez hit a single up the middle to score the Dons 3rd run but centerfielder Cody Foster fielded the ball and threw a strike to David Luna and the second runner was tagged out to end the game.

“This was a good win for our team today,” explained Head Coach Jordon Twohig. “ We played solid defense and were able to win a 1-run ball game over a solid club.”

With the win the Renegades move to 11-3 on the year and look to take the series sweep tomorrow. Sean Martin will be taking the hill for Ohlone and will be looking for his 4th win of the year.
