CUPERTINO, CA- In the 3rd and final game of the series the Ohlone College Renegades (12-3) defeated the De Anza Dons by a score of 10-1. Freshmen started Sean Martin earned his 4th win of the year by going 8 innings, giving up 2 hits, 1 earned run, and struck out 6 Don batters.

Ohlone turned up the heat offensively by pounding out 14 hits in the final game. Steven Ramos went 3 for 5 with 3 runs scored and Jeff Johnson hit his 4th homerun of the year and 2nd of the series.

The Renegades got off to a quick start in the top of the first. Ramos and Cody Foster both singled then stole bases to get into scoring position for the Johnson brothers. Zack Johnson then delivered a sac fly that scored Ramos from third. Jeff Johnson then singled to center scoring Foster from second base. After a couple of balks by the De Anza pitcher, Johnson scored on a Kyle Holmstrom (Granada) ground out to short.

The story of the day was Sean Martin. Martin had a good fastball with command of both sides of the plate, a devastating change-up, and a good breaking ball that kept the De Anza hitters off balance all day.

Pitching Coach Dan Lewis commented after the game, "Sean had 3 pitches for a strike today, with that type of command he is tough to beat."

Ohlone now heads back home to face Sacramento City College on Tuesday. Ian Hoff will be the starting pitcher for the Renegades as they look to even up the season series.
