

BASEBALL PUTS 28 RUNS ON GAVILAN IN THE WIN

GILROY, CA – The Ohlone College baseball team (14-3, 1-0) opened up Pacific-Coast Conference play with a bang this afternoon by defeating Gavilan College by the score of 28-9. 15 different Ohlone batters had hits on the afternoon. Ohlone Starter Alex Oberle (3-0) from Santa Theresa High School earned his 3rd win of the season. Oberle pitched 4 innings, striking out 2 batters and allowing just 4 hits.



Ohlone got things going in the 1st inning when Steven Ramos scored on a wild pitch to start the scoring for Ohlone. Designated Hitter Jeff Johnson hitter kept the scoring going in the 1st when he belted his 5th Home run of the season with 2 outs to make the score 2-0.

Gavilan starter Robert Sylveira who was saddled with the loss was pulled after the 1st inning. The Renegades broke the game open in the 2nd inning as they plated 8 runs in their half of the 2nd. Big hits in the inning came from Steven Ramos who had a 2RBI single to left field, and Jeff Johnson, who in his 2nd at bat hit a 3 run Home run, his 6th of the year. Johnson finished the day 3-3 with 2 HR, 1 3B and 4 RBI. The big 8 run inning proved to be the winning inning.

Ohlone scored 18 more runs over 6 innings. Other Renegades who had good days at the plate were Outfielder Ryan Kanzaki who was 4-4 with a 2B, a walk, and 2 RBI, Infielder JoJo Hernandez who was 2-3 with 3 RBI, Catcher Braxton Miller who was 2-3 with 2B, 3B and 3 RBI, Infielder Kyle Holmstrom was 3-4, Cody Foster was 2-3 with an RBI, Catcher David Keller was 3-3 with 3 RBI, Shortstop Will Bourgein was 2-4 with a walk, and Ryan Walterhouse was 2-7 with an RBI.

Also adding to the offense with a hit on the afternoon was Brad Reeves who had a 2 strike HR his 1st of the season. Cody Honea had an RBI single in the 8th inning, and Michael Ussery has 2 hits and an RBI.

“I was very proud of the way our player came ready to play today,” Said Head baseball Coach Jordon Twohig. “The offense gave us a big lift, and Alex (Oberle) did a fine job giving us a quality start.”

Ohlone Relievers Cory Krisman and Kevin Radach combined for 6 strikeouts in 4 innings off work.

Ohlone continues in Coast Conference play this Saturday at home as they play host to Hartnell College. Game time is set for 11:00am in Fremont.
