



Renegades Prevail over Hartnell 11-8

Jeff Johnson hits game winning Grand Slam

FREMONT, CA - The Ohlone Renegades defeated the Hartnell Panthers by a score of 11-8 on Saturday. With the win, the Renegades move to 15-3, (2-0) on the year. Ian Hoff received his 2nd win of the year in relief by pitching 4 innings, giving up 1 hit, 1 earned run, and striking out 2 Panther batters to preserve the victory for Ohlone.

Offense was the key again today for the Renegades as they pounded out 10 hits and scored 11 runs on the day. Steven Ramos, Jeff Johnson, and Brad Reeves all had multi hit days. Ramos was 2 for 5, had 3 RBI's, scored 2 runs, and stole 2 more bases. With those steals Ramos raises his season total to 19 on the year, among the tops in the state. Brad Reeves added 2 hits of his own and also scored a run for the Renegades. Johnson's 2nd hit came at a big time for the Renegades. In the bottom of the 8th, Ohlone was trailing by a score of 8-7 when they loaded the bases with 2 outs. Jeff crushed a 1-1 pitch over the right-center fence off Hartnell reliever Rick Miyamoto for a grand slam. Ian Hoff would then seal the 11-8 lead in the 9th with a 1-2-3 inning.

The Renegades move to 15-3 on the year and 2-0 in conference play. Ohlone takes the field at home again on Tuesday against Canada College at 2:00pm. Sophomore David Luna will be taking the mound and will be trying to add to his 3-0 record.
