

Ohlone defeats Monterey Peninsula 7-5

Hoff earns his 5th victory

Fremont, Ca- The #1 ranked Ohlone Renegades (21-5 – 8-2) defeated the Monterey Peninsula Lobos by a score of 7-5. Sophomore Ian Hoff received his 5th win of the year in relief by pitching 2 1/3 innings, giving up 0 hits, 0 runs, and striking out 4 Monterey hitters.

The Renegades scored 5 times in the 7th inning to overcome a 3-2 deficit. With 2 outs and runners on 1st and 2nd Ryan Walterhouse singled up the middle to score Aaron Chavez. After an intentional walk to Braxton Miller, Zach Johnson reached base on a error by the Lobo shortstop. On the play, Aaron Plimmer and Ryan Walterhouse both scored to make to score 5-3 Ohlone. Brad Reeves then followed with a clutch single, with 2 strikes, to left field that scored Miller and Johnson and gave the Renegades the lead for good.

The Renegades were lead offensively by Braxton Miller and Tanner Laran who both had multi hit days and both reached base 3 times a piece. Walterhouse, Miller, and Reeves all contributed huge RBI's on the day to help give the Renegades the victory. "I really though Tanner Laran lifted our offense today", said Head Coach Jordon Twohig. " he had three quality at bats and put some good swings on the ball, it's nice to see a kid that works as hard as he does be rewarded."

Sean Martin started the game for Ohlone and pitched well again. Sean's line for the day was, 6 innings pitched, 9 hits, 3 runs, and 1 strike out. Cory Krisman also pitched in relief for Ohlone; closing the door by getting the last two outs of the game.

"I was very proud of Sean for giving us another quality start again today," said Coach Twohig. "Monterey is a good hitting team, and Sean kept that to a minimum today."

Ohlone will continue the home stand this Saturday against the Community College of San Francisco. Freshman Roberto Padilla will look to have a repeat outing such as he had last Saturday. First pitch is set for 12:00pm.
