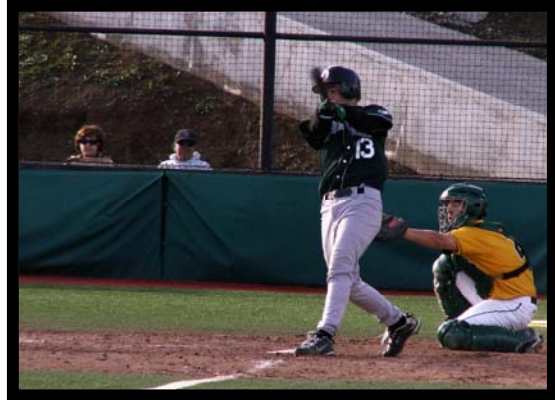


Kanzaki Homers lead Ohlone over Skyline

Martin earns his 6th win of the year

San Bruno, Ca- The Ohlone Renegades (24-5, 11-2) defeated the host Skyline Trojans on Thursday by a score of 10-3. Freshmen Sean Martin earned his 6th win of the season and Ryan Kanzaki smacked to 2 home runs on the day. Martin pitched 7 2/3 innings giving up 7 hits, 3 runs, and struck out 8 Trojan batters. Martin held the Skyline offense scoreless for 6 straight innings, giving the Renegade offense ample time to put up runs.

The Renegades got to work in the 2nd inning. With 1 out, Zach Johnson walked and Ryan Walterhouse soon followed with a single to left field. Ryan Kanzaki stepped to the plate and deposited a 0-2 fastball over the right field fence to tie the score 3-3. The blast was Kanzaki's first of the year but it would not be his last.

With the game knotted at 3 for 3 innings, Ohlone broke the tie in their half of the 6th inning. After Braxton Miller walked, Zach Johnson laced a double down the left field line that put runners at 2nd and 3rd with 1 out. Walterhouse came through with a sacrifice fly to left field that scored Miller on the play. The Renegades would not wait long to add to their 1 run lead.

The bats exploded in the 8th, putting Ohlone ahead for good. Cody Foster started the 6 run rally with a single to right field. Jeff Johnson walked and Miller singled to load the bases for Zach Johnson. On the first pitch, Johnson smashed a double off the left field wall to score Foster and Jeff Johnson. Walterhouse would then single home Miller to make the score 7-3. Still with nobody out Ryan Kanzaki stepped to the plate. Kanzaki took a fastball on the outside corner and drilled it over the right field wall for a 3 run homerun. The homerun was Kanzaki's second of the game and gave the Sophomore 6 RBI's for the day. The blast would close out the scoring for the Renegades as they would pound out 10 runs on 9 hits.

Offensively, the Renegades were lead by Kanzaki (2 for 4, 6 RBI's, 2 HR's, 2 runs scored), Zach Johnson (2 for 3, 2 2b's, 2 RBI's, 2 BB, 2 runs scored), and Ryan Walterhouse (2 for 4, 2 RBI's, 2 runs scored).

The Renegades will now head back home to the Reservation to take on the Canada Colts. Game time is set for Saturday March 28th at 12:00pm. Freshmen Roberto Padilla will be on the bump for the Renegades and will be looking to earn his 3rd win of the year.
