

# Renegades take season series from Seahawks

*Sean Martin earns 8<sup>th</sup> win*

**Aptos, Ca-** The Ohlone Renegades (31-7, 16-3) took down the Cabrillo Seahawks by a score of 10-2. With the win, Ohlone wins the season series against the Seahawks 2-1. Freshman Sean Martin (8-0) snagged his 8<sup>th</sup> win of the season by pitching 7 2/3 innings, scattering 7 hits, allowing 2 runs, and striking out 5 Cabrillo hitters. Sophomore Kevin Radach pitched the final 1 1/3 innings. Radach came in for Martin with runners at 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> and proceeded to induce a pop up to center field to get the Renegades out of the 8<sup>th</sup> inning. On the day, Radach allowed 2 hits, 0 runs, and struck out 1 Seahawk batter.

The Renegades offense came alive on Thursday. Ohlone pounded out 20 hits and scored 10 runs on the sunny afternoon. Leading the Renegades were **Steven Ramos** (3-5, 2 runs, 2 SB, 1 BB), **Jeff Johnson** (4-5, 2B, 3 RBI's, 2 runs), **Zach Johnson** (3-5, 2 2B's, 1 run, 1 RBI), **Brad Reeves** and **Ryan Walterhouse** both crushed triples to the right center field gap, and **Aaron Plimmer** went big fly as he connected for his 2<sup>nd</sup> homerun of the year.

In the first inning, Ramos led off with a sharp single to left. **Cody Foster** then sacrifice bunted Ramos to 2<sup>nd</sup> base. With 1 out, Jeff Johnson laced a single up the middle that would score Ramos easily.

In the top half of the 3<sup>rd</sup> inning, the Renegades were at it again. Ramos was again the catalyst of Ohlone's 3 run inning. Ramos led off with a walk and then quickly stole 2<sup>nd</sup> base to put him in scoring position. Jeff Johnson would then tattoo a fastball down the left field line to score Ramos and give Jeff his 50<sup>th</sup> RBI of the year. Jeff would then move to 3<sup>rd</sup> on a **Braxton Miller** single and then score as his brother **Zach Johnson** doubled to left field. **Ryan Kanzaki** would hit a deep fly ball to right field to score Miller and cap the Renegades 3 run rally.

Ohlone would put up 6 more runs throughout the ballgame but the highlight of the day came in the Renegades last at bat. With the score 8-2, Brad Reeves led off the 9<sup>th</sup> by unloading on a fastball to right center field for a triple. **JoJo Hernandez** would then lift a fly ball to right that would be deep enough to score Reeves from 3<sup>rd</sup>. Aaron Plimmer would then finish off the scoring for the Renegades with some fireworks. Plimmer crushed a deep homerun to right field that would have been out of any ballpark. The homerun was Aaron's 2<sup>nd</sup> of the year.

With the win, #1 ranked Ohlone remains on top of the Coast-Pacific Conference with a record of 16-3. Ohlone will now head back to the Reservation in Fremont to take on the Canada Colts. Sophomore David Luna will get the start for Ohlone and will be going for his 7<sup>th</sup> win of the season. Game time is set for 12:00 pm.
