

12 Renegades Graduate to 4-Year Schools

Ohlone has 12 Players Sign Athletic Scholarships

FREMONT, CA – It is a fitting end to a great 2009 season for Ohlone baseball. Ohlone baseball experienced tremendous success going 37-11 and making it to the Elite 8 in the State playoffs. Ohlone's 37 wins broke the single season record for most wins in Ohlone College baseball history. All 12 Ohlone renegade s players (11- sophomores, 1 – freshman) have signed scholarships to play at a four year college or university in 2010. "I am extremely proud of all of these young men", explained Head Coach Jordon Twohig. "It is not easy being a student-athlete, but these players put the needed time in the classroom, and on the field to earn these scholarships." 5 players are going to Division I school, 4 players are going to Division II schools, and 3 players are headed to NAIA schools.



David Luna- RHP: San Jose State (Division I – Western Athletic Conference)

- David was a 2 year starter for Ohlone College, earning 1st team All-Coast Conference honors in 2008, and 2009. This spring Luna was tied for the team lead in wins with 9, and had a 3.95 ERA striking out 65 batters in 82 innings pitched. He was also selected All-Northern California in 2008. He will play going to play for head Coach Sam Piraro and his coaching staff this upcoming season.

Sean Martin – RHP: San Jose State (Division I – Western Athletic Conference)

- Martin was 8-1 for the renegades this spring as a freshman. He had 72 strikeouts in 91 IP, had a 2.76 ERA, and was voted 1st Team All-Coast Conference. He will play going to play for Head Coach Sam Piraro and his coaching staff this upcoming season.

Ian Hoff – RHP: University of Oregon (Division I - Pac-10 Conference)

- Hoff finished the 2009 season with the #1 ERA in the state of California-1.25. he was 9-3 for the renegades and struck out 57 batters in 83 innings pitched. Ian managed to only walk 6 batters give up only 12 earned runs all season. Hoff was named to the All-Coast Conference 1st team, as well as 1st Team All-Northern

California. Hoff was also named to the ABCA All – American Team. He is the 1st pitcher in Ohlone College history to earn this honor. He will be playing for Head Coach George Horton and the Oregon Ducks this upcoming season.



Aaron Chavez – SS: Eastern Michigan University (Division I – Mid-American Conference)

- Chavez started all 48 games for Ohlone this season hitting .272 with 34 hits and 12 RBI. Chavez was the leader in the infield and helped lead the conference in double plays turned. He finished the season with a .963 fielding percentage and a .401 on base percentage, walking 22 times. Chavez was an honorable mention to the All-Coast Conference in 2009 and was a team captain for this year squad. He will be playing for Head Coach Jay Alexander at Eastern Michigan University this upcoming spring.

Braxton Miller – C: Lewis and Clark State College (NAIA – Frontier Conference)

- Miller was a 2-year starter behind the plate for Ohlone. He was voted to the All-Coast Conference 1st team both years. Miller was selected for the California Community College All-Star game in the fall. This season Miller batted .326 with 12 2B, 3 3B, and 16 RBI. He also stole 17 bases for the Renegades. Miller will be going to play for the legendary Head Coach Ed Chef, and the 16 time National Champion Lewis and Clark State.

Alex Oberle – RHP: South Dakota State (Division I – Summit League)

- Oberle was 3-1 for the renegades this past fall with 19 strikeouts in 20 innings pitched. Oberle pitched for Gavilan College in 2008 throwing 71 innings pitched and was named to the All-Coast Conference 2nd team. Oberle will be playing for Head Coach Richie Price and his staff at South Dakota State University in the Summit Conference.

Cory Krisman – RHP: California State University, Chico (Division II – CCAA)

- Cory was a 2 year pitcher for Ohlone. Krisman was 3-0 on the mound this past spring. Krisman had 38 strikeouts in 28 innings pitched. Krisman also had 1 save on the season. As a freshman Krisman was 3-4 on the mound. Cory was selected to the California Community College All-Star game this past fall. Krisman will be playing for Head Coach Dave Taylor and his staff at Chico State this upcoming season.

Kevin Radach – RHP: Colorado State University, Pueblo (Division II – RMAC)

- Radach was a 2 year pitcher for Ohlone. Radach had a 1-0 record with 16 strikeouts in 14 innings pitched. This past year in the super regional tournament, Radach had 3 strong innings of scoreless relief pitching for the Renegades. Radach will be going to play for Head Coach Stan Sanchez and his staff at Colorado State University, Pueblo this upcoming season.

David Keller – C: University of Hawaii-Hilo (Division II – Pacific West Conference)

- Keller was a catcher for 2 years in the Ohlone baseball program. Keller played a major role in the programs success over the past 2 seasons. Keller finished the 2009 season batting .324 with 3 2B and 6 RBI with and on base percentage of .500. Keller will be going to play next season at the University of Hawaii-Hilo for Head Coach Joey Estrella and his coaching staff.

Ryan Harmon – IF: Grand Canyon University (Division II – Pacific West Conference)

- Harmon played for Ohlone for 2 years. In 2009 he batted .325 with 13 hits and 9 RBI. Harmon had the game winning hit to win the 2009 regional Championship for Ohlone in extra innings. Harmon was voted on by his peers as team captain of the '09 squad. He will play next season for Head Coach Dave Stapleton and his coaching staff at Grand Canyons University.

Ryan Kanzaki – OF: Dickinson State University (NAIA – Dakota Athletic Conference)

- Kanzaki had a monster year for Ohlone. After red-shirting in 2008, Kanzaki earned 1st team All-Coast Conference honors in 2009 hitting .391 and leading the Ohlone offense in batting average. He had 6 2B, 17 RBI and a .436 on base percentage. Kanzaki will play for Head Coach Duane Monlux and his coaching staff this upcoming spring.
