

# RENEGADES SWEEP

## #5 SACRAMENTO CITY

*Ohlone's Offense Combines for 26 Runs in 18 Innings!*

February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2010

**Fremont, Ca-** The Ohlone Renegades (**5-2, 0-0**) won both games of a double header against Sacramento City College on Saturday. Ohlone won game 1, **9-5**, and then took game 2 in convincing fashion, **17-2**. Freshman **Matt Fontaine** (1-1) earned the victory in Game 1 by pitching 7 innings, allowing 5 runs on 8 hits, and struck out 3 Panther batters. Sophomore **Roberto Padilla** (3-0) earned his third victory of the season by throwing 5 innings, allowing 2 runs on 6 hits, and striking out 6 batters.

### Game 1 Recap



The action started quickly as the Renegades opened the scoring in a big way. With 1 out in the bottom of the first inning, Sophomore **Cody Foster** singled. After an out, Sophomore **Jeff Johnson** hammered a fastball over the left field wall for his 1<sup>st</sup> homerun of the season. The blast gave Ohlone a quick 2-0 lead. Ohlone would tack on another run in the 3<sup>rd</sup>. Sophomore **Steven Ramos** used his wheels to get to third base on an error by Sac City's right fielder and then later scored on a single by Freshman **Sean Yoshikawa**. The lead wouldn't last for long, as the Panther's rallied to score 5 times in their half of the 4<sup>th</sup> inning.

Ohlone's offense would answer the challenge with some more fireworks. In the bottom of the 4<sup>th</sup>, Freshman **Michael Briseno** crushed a home run over the left center field wall to cut the deficit to 1. After Fontaine guided Ohlone through the 5<sup>th</sup>, Freshman **Christian Weeber** joined the fun as he homered over the left field wall with 2 men on base for a huge 3 run homer. Later in the 6<sup>th</sup> inning, Ramos would homer to left field to give Ohlone a 8-5 lead. Immediately, Foster and Johnson teamed up again to give the Renegades another run. Foster singled and then stole 2<sup>nd</sup> base. After a

walk to Yoshikawa, Johnson singled down the left field line to bring in Foster and give the Renegades a 9-5 advantage.

With a 4 run lead, Ohlone called on Freshmen **Brandon Arata** and **George Asmus** to close out the win. The two youngsters combined to throw 2 shutout innings, allowing only 1 hit. The win moved Ohlone's record to **(4-2, 0-0)** on the year.

### Game 2 Recap



In Game 2, the story was the offense for Ohlone. The Renegades pounded out 17 runs on 21 hits in route to an easy victory, 17-2. Ramos, Weeber, and Sophomore **Michael Di Rocco** lead the charge, with each player garnering multi-hit games.

After taking the lead in the 2<sup>nd</sup> inning on a 2 out RBI double by Sophomore **Michael Ussery**, the Renegades offense exploded in the 3<sup>rd</sup> inning. The Renegades sent 16 batters to the plate as they scored an amazing 12 times in the frame. This run support was more than enough as Padilla pitch well through 5 innings of work, giving way to fellow Sophomore **Jon Fragulia** in the 6<sup>th</sup>. Frags had a nice afternoon as he pitched a scoreless 4 innings of relief, scattering 3 hits on the day.

Leading the offensive charge for Ohlone were Ramos, (3 for 5, 2b, run), Foster (2 for 3, 2 RBI's, 2 runs), Weeber (2 for 3, 3 RBI's, run), Di Rocco (3 for 4, 3 RBI's, run), and Ussery (2 for 5, 2b, 3 RBI's, 2 runs).

Ohlone **(5-2, 0-0)** will now head to San Mateo this Tuesday to take on the Bulldogs. Sophomore Justin Kuks will get the start. Game time is set for 2:00pm in San Mateo.
