



Ohlone Baseball Players Shine at 2009 Northern California All-Star Game



November 7, 2009 - Sacramento, CA - Four members of the Ohlone College baseball team had a chance to show their skills this past weekend at Sacramento State University. Roberto Padilla – P, Michael Ussery –SS, Steven Ramos – OF, and Zach Johnson - 3B played in front of 50 different college recruiters and over 25



professional scouts. The all-star JC showcase is made up of the top community college players from all over northern California as voted on by the college coaches and the executive committee of the CCCBA. A 5th member of the Renegades baseball team –Jeff Johnson -1B/OF was also voted in but could not participate during the weekend.



Roberto Padilla was the only Ohlone pitcher at the event on Sunday. Padilla competed well and was able to keep hitters off balance in his outing; he had three ground balls and a pop up in the infield against the 4 batters he faced. 3b- Zach Johnson made 2 nice plays defensively and had 2 hits on the afternoon. Infielder Michael Ussery had a triple and helped turn 2 double plays in his time on the infield, and Outfielder Steven Ramos also had a triple and stole 2 bases in the game.
