SUBJECT: One-Year Probationary Faculty Contracts

At its meeting of February 24, 1993, the Board of Trustees approved the replacement of Board Policy 3.9.3.5.A.2 and 3.9.3.5.A.3 with Education Code Sections 87602-87611 as applicable. The former Board Policy provided for a two-year tenure cycle; the new policy provisions permit a four-year tenure cycle. New faculty may earn tenure at the end of the first year of employment, at the end of the second year, or at the end of the fourth year. After faculty members complete their first year, the Board may:

- 1) Not enter into a contract for the following academic year; or

- 3) Employ the contract employee as a regular employee for all subsequent academic years.
