CONTRACTOR REQUIREMENTS:

1. All administrative functions relative to WIA expenditures will be covered by non-WIA resources; administrative costs will be identified and tracked by the One-Stop Operator.
2. Contractor will track, report and invoice expenditures for the delivery of: core, intensive, and training services, as defined by WIA & the WIB; and other costs of One-Stop operation as “other services” per the invoice form provided by the Alameda County WIB.
3. Contractor will be required to provide a minimum of six (6) On-the-Job Training (OJT) services to clients.
4. Contractor will be responsible for meeting PY2005-2006 final performance goals issued by the State.
5. Contractor will be responsible for providing post-placement follow-up services for 12 months after the first day of employment.
6. Contractor will be responsible for the coordination of services for up to 110 participants trained for entry-level biotech positions as part of the DOL Biotech grant. Contractor will coordinate training services and provide counseling and assessment for intern positions.

BUSINESS SERVICES SUPPORT STIPULATIONS:

The Business Services Support grant \$5,435 from the Tri-Cities One-Stop Career Center, Newark and \$7,631 from the Tri-Cities One-Stop Career Center, Fremont shall be used to augment business services. All Business Services Representatives:

- a. must attend ACWIB Economic Development and Employer Services Committee, and participate when appropriate in other activities of the ACWIB;
- b. must attend meetings called by the ACWIB Business Services Director; and
- c. must implement programs developed by the ACWIB Business Services Director pursuant to the strategic plan for business services.

STAFF-ASSISTED SERVICES (CORE B) PILOT PROJECT STIPULATIONS:

One-Stops must incorporate the full award amount into the full contract budget for the year. Funds under this award may be invoiced on a cost-reimbursement basis. These funds are subject to the Recapture & Redistribution Policy.
