SUBJECT: Acceptance of the Local 790 Service Employee's International Union's Initial Bargaining Proposal for 2005/2006 and Approval of the Sunshining Timetable

The District has received the initial bargaining proposal from the Service Employees International Union (SEIU), Chapter 790, on limited contract re-opens for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2005-2006 (Attachment). Section 3547 of the Government Code and Board Policy 13.1, Public Notice Procedure Relating to Meeting and Negotiating under the Educational Employment Relations Act (EERA), mandate public postings and public hearings of all initial proposals submitted by the exclusive bargaining organization and counterproposals of the Board of Trustees. This "sunshine law" mandate allows the public to be informed and to express at a public meeting any opinions regarding content of such proposals. By law, the parties are not permitted to commence negotiations until the provisions of Government Code Section 3547 are fully complied with. In light of this, the following negotiation timetables are proposed:
