Dr. Ron Quinta, Dean for Math, Science, Engineering and Technology, and the faculty in the Compute Science Department, led by Assistant Professor David Topham, have developed a proposal for a new Associate in Science Transfer Degree in Computer Engineering. This degree will prepare students for baccalaureate majors in Computer Engineering. By fulfilling many of the lower division major requirements at the CSU and UC campuses, this program will enhance successful student transfer. The new program application prepared for submission to the California Community College Chancellor's Office for approval is attached for your review.

This new degree proposal has been reviewed and approved by the President's Cabinet, the Faculty Senate, the Course and Program Approval Committee (CAPAC), and Dr. Jim Wright, Vice President of Instruction.

RECOMMENDATION:

The President/Superintendent recommends that the Board of Trustees approve the Associate in Science Transfer Degree in Computer Engineering and authorize the President/ Superintendent to submit the new program application to the California Community College Chancellor's Office for approval.
