

**OHLONE COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT**

**RESOLUTION NO. 31/05-06**

**WHEREAS,** Education Code Section 5016 provides that, prior to conducting any school board election on and after March 1, 1977, the governing board of each school district shall establish whether a tie vote of two or more candidates for a term of office of a governing board member shall be determined by a lot or by calling a run-off election.

**WHEREAS,** the Board of Trustees heretofore passed and adopted Resolutions No. 76/95-96, and 43/01-02 setting forth District policy on election matters, and now the Board desires to rescind said Resolutions;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOVED,** that the governing board of the Ohlone Community College District of Alameda County hereby determined that a tie vote of two or more candidates for member of the governing board of the District shall be determined by lot.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOVED** that the aforementioned Resolutions No. 76/95-96, and No. 43/01-02 be and the same are hereby rescinded.
