SUBJECT: Revised Ohlone College Mission Statement

Consent Agenda

WASC accreditation requires that the college periodically review our mission statement. The specific language from WASC indicates:

Using the institution's governance and decision-making processes, the institution reviews its mission statement on a regular basis and revises it as necessary.

The current Mission Statement for Ohlone College reads as follows:

"The mission of Ohlone College is to serve the community by providing a center for career, technology, science, and liberal arts education; cultural enrichment, economic development, and lifelong learning. The College affirms its commitment to open access for all adults who can benefit from its instruction."

College Council has reviewed and approved a revised Mission Statement to better align it with the learning college model and the District Vision and Goals. The proposed revised Mission Statement reads as follows:

"Ohlone College offers instruction for basic skills, career entry, university transfer, economic development, and personal enrichment for all who can benefit from our instruction in an environment where student learning success is highly valued, supported, and continually assessed."

RECOMMENDATION

The President/Superintendent recommends approval of the revised Mission Statement for Ohlone College, as revised and approved by College Council.
