College Leadership Priorities 2007-08

The following are the priority action items for the Board of Trustees and the College President for 2007-08, based on the District Strategic Goals.

Goal 1: Promote appreciation for and understanding of diverse races and culture by expanding the diversity of college personnel, international education offerings and exchanges, cross-cultural curricula, and ethnic/cultural events

Action: Expand exchange and training program in China and introduce new exchange program with India (President and Board)

Goal 2: Develop across the curriculum the Learning College Model, utilizing methods and technologies that hold the most promise for improving student course and program completion success rates

Action: Achieve Title III measurable objectives for 2007-08 (President)

Goal 3: Develop strategies to increase the proportion of full-time students including learning communities, cohort groups, enhanced facilities, and improved course availability

Action: Develop and implement a three year enrollment development plan (President and Board)

Goal 4: Provide continuous learning for all personnel associated with the District and promote an organizational structure that is adaptable, collegial, and supportive of the Learning College Model

Action: Provide linkage between Board sub-committees and College Council (President)

Action: Board developed mechanism for regular reports on College Leadership Priorities (Board)

Action: Approve WASC Self-Study overall and engage in Standard IV specifically (Board)

Goal 5: Promote the health, environmental, cultural, and economic vitality of the communities served by the District through programs of outreach, community service, and partnership ventures

Action: Develop and approve A.A. Degree in Environmental Studies (President and Board)

Goal 6: Promote and maintain an accessible, clean, safe, and healthy college environment through continuous engagement of students and college personnel in campus preparedness, wellness, beautification, universal design, and environmental sustainability

Action: Approve Sustainability Policy and Implement District-wide Measures of Environmental Responsibility (President and Board)

Goal 7: Increase public and private funds for educational programs, equipment, and facilities through entrepreneurial activities, grants, and the college foundation

Action: Approve and develop lease of frontage surplus property to create ongoing source of capital improvements funding (Board and President)

Action: Raise through the College Foundation at least \$5 million in Capital Campaign (President and Board)

Action: Develop and approve three year budget/enrollment plan (Board and President)

Goal 8: Develop and implement a District-wide facilities plan which encompasses the design, construction (including furnishings and equipment), renovation and major scheduled maintenance of College facilities that support programs and enhance student and employee success.

Action: Provide building naming opportunities for Capital Campaign (Board and President)

Action: Develop and implement comprehensive Information Technology plan, program and services delivery upgrade (President)
