**NEWARK CENTER FOR HEALTH SCIENCES AND TECHNOLOGY

**WHEREAS**, the Ohlone Community College District has approved a policy to adopt principles of sustainability; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohlone Community College District is committed to targeting LEED Platinum certification from the U.S. Green Building Council for the Newark Center for Health Sciences and Technology; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohlone Community College District is committed to earn LEED Credit SSc5.2-Reduce Site Disturbance-Development Footprint; and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohlone Community College District is to provide an area at minimum equal to the Newark Center's footprint which is 63,374 square feet; and

**WHEREAS**, wetland property of 118,473 square feet on the south east property line at the Newark Center for Health Sciences and Technology has been identified and referenced on the attached site plan (exhibit 1); and

**WHEREAS**, the Ohlone Community College commits to preserving this 118,473 square feet area for the life of the Newark Center for Health Sciences and Technology; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the Ohlone Community College Board of Trustees commits to preserving the wet land open space for the life of the Newark Center.
