RESOLUTION NO. 19/09-10

RESOLUTION REDUCING ACADEMIC STAFF

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Ohlone Community College District has determined that the particular kinds of services set forth herein be reduced or discontinued; and

WHEREAS, it is the opinion of the Board that because of the aforementioned reason it is necessary and in the best interest of the District that the number of faculty of the District be reduced.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Governing Board of the Ohlone Community College District as follows:

- A. That the following particular kinds of services be reduced or eliminated commencing the 2010-2011 academic year:

3.0 FTE COUNSELORS

- B. That due to the reduction or elimination of particular kinds of service, it is necessary that the legal number of employees of the District be terminated pursuant to Education Code section 87743,
- C. That the reduction of staff by these stated FTEs will be effected by the termination of faculty employees and not by terminating temporary and substitute employees, and that any of the services listed above that are performed by adjunct faculty or as overload will also be eliminated, and
- D. That the District President (or designee) is directed to initiate layoff procedures pursuant to Education Code sections 87740 and 87743.
