CONTEST RULES:

This art contest is sponsored by the Associated Students of Ohlone College (ASOC), in conjunction with the ASOC Speakers Committee, Liberated Individuals for the Environment (LIFE) Club, and the Ohlone Sustainability Committee (the "Sponsors") The contest begins on March 17th, 2008 and ends on April 17th, 2008 (The "Contest Period"). No entries will be accepted after April 17th at 5:00 PM

1. How To Enter:

To enter, each participant must completely fill out, sign, and submit the information and materials required on the contest entry form (the "Entry Form") available from the ASOC Room 1130, and from the LIFE Club. Limit one entry per participant. Sponsors reserve the right to confirm facts provided on the Entry Form and submission of an Entry constitutes permission for Sponsors to use the information and materials contained in the Entry Form, for advertising and promotional purposes without compensation.

2. Contest:

The Contest is open to all students currently enrolled at Ohlone Community College in Fremont or the Newark Center for the Health Sciences and Technology in Newark, or Online through Distance Learning. Each piece of art work must be an original, signed piece of work done exclusively by the participant on paper, canvas, or poster board, and must be ready to be hung using a "S" hook. All work must be a minimum of 6 by 6 inches (or 36 square inches) and a maximum of 30 by 30 inches (or 900 square inches). All coloring and painting media accepted, including crayon, pencil, water color, acrylic paints, marker and collage (but no clay or sculptural works will be accepted). All photography, black and white, and color will be accepted. All entries must be delivered to the ASOC Room 1130 on the Fremont Main Campus at 43600 Mission Blvd, Fremont, CA 94539 to an ASOC or LIFE Club Member on Thursday, April 17th, 2008 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM. If you can not make these times, please e-mail ASOC+Earth@ohlone.edu to arrange a time.

3. Judging:

Entries will be judged on originality, style, use of color, creative expression, and relevance to the contest subject topics. Judging will be done by the students, staff, faculty and administration attending Earth Week Festivities on Monday, April 21st, 2008 and Tuesday, April 22nd, 2008 during the scheduled Earth Week Events.

4. Prizes:

There shall be a First Place Winner, Second Place Winner, Third Place Winner, and Honorable Mentions (up to three). Winning entries will be displayed in the Building 1 Lobby of the Fremont Campus Wednesday, April 23rd, 2008 and Thursday, April 24th, 2008 and the Newark Campus Friday, April 25th, 2008. Prizes will NOT be awarded at the Earth Week Event but will be available from the ASOC beginning Monday, April 28th, 2008 from the Campus Activities/EOPS Window at the Fremont Campus. Winners will be notified by phone or e-mail and will be responsible for picking up their prizes and art work at the ASOC Room 1130.

5. Eligibility:

The Contest is open to all students of the Ohlone Community College District. Entry materials become the property of Sponsors and will not be acknowledged or returned, however they may be retrieved by the participant in the week after the event at the ASOC Room 1130 on Thursday, May 1, 2008 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM, If you cannot make these times, please e-mail ASOC+Earth@ohlone.edu. Sponsors are not responsible for lost, damaged, unsigned entries, unsuccessful attempts to notify the prize recipients or art work left after May 1st, 2008. All artwork and materials submitted as part of the Entry Form must be participant's own original work.

6. Conditions:

All Ohlone College rules and regulations apply. By submitting an entry Form, each participant agrees to be bound by these Contest Rules, and the decisions of the Sponsors are final. Each participant agrees to release and hold Sponsors and their representatives harmless from any and all damages, losses, claims and/or liabilities arising out of his or her participation in the Contest or resulting from acceptance or claiming of any prize. Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to terminate, suspend or otherwise cancel the Contest at any time. Income and other taxes are the responsibility of the prize recipient.

7. Use of Information:

Upon submission, each entry and the Entry Form become the property of the Sponsors and each participant agrees that any and all portions of the material and information provided with the Entry Form may be used by the ASOC during and after the event. Images and likenesses of any art work submitted may be retained and used by the ASOC for promotional purposes. Original art work can be picked up by the contestants upon completion of the Event.

Winners and images of their artwork will be published in the Ohlone Monitor after Earth Week.
