ENVIRONMENTAL STEWARDSHIP

The courses include an emphasis on a scientific understanding of the environment, social and economic concepts, and an awareness of the behaviors that protect or damage the earth and its resources. On completion of this certificate students will have the ability to better understand their relationship with the planet and obtain an understanding of how their behavior affects the environment they inhabit. This certificate provides an excellent background for the various careers in the fields of environmental studies and environmental sciences.

1. Recognize the major components of the earth's systems, how they function, and are manipulated by political, economic, social, and educational forces.
2. Discuss and describe the impacts made of individuals on global resources and recognize the patterns of unequal distribution of those resources worldwide.
3. Apply scientific and environmental concepts in studying the environment.
4. Recognize the link between healthy ecosystems (air, water, and land) and healthy human populations.
5. Critically examine all sides of environmental issues and apply understanding of ecological principles to create informed opinions about how to live.
