FALL SEMESTER ADAPTIVE PHYSICAL EDUCATION (A.P.E.) CLASSES

These classes are designed for students with a disability.

A.P.E. STRENGTH TRAINING offers the student an individualized strengthening and conditioning program. This course is aimed at developing physical strength and skills for optimal daily living. Course content includes conditioning, resisting, and muscular strengthening.

A.P.E STRIDING offers individualized cardiovascular conditioning and gradual endurance development.

A.P.E. AQUATIC EXERCISE offers the student a complete aquatic program. This course consists of exercises (in water) for all areas of the body. Exercise in water has several advantages such as: 1) enhancing circulation by the water's natural massaging action on the body; 2) permitting mobility not possible out of water by the body's natural buoyancy in water, and 3) promoting deeper breathing through better use of the lung capacity.
