

BP 3xxx Minors on Campus

Reference: *Welfare Institutions Code 625*.

Board Approved:

Ohlone College visitors, students, faculty, and staff are not permitted to bring minor children on campus or other District facilities, with the following exceptions:

- Children enrolled in the Child Development Center
- Minors accompanying an adult to public events or attending college events for which adult supervision is provided
- Minors accompanying an adult who is accessing student services, library facilities, or other services district-wide
- Minors attending college classes or programs for which they are officially enrolled
- Minors accompanying adults to instructional activities at the specific request of the instructor or with the express permission of the instructor

Children on campus are here at the risk of the supervising adult who brings them. No liability will be accepted by the District nor any of its agents or staff for the consequences of children being on campus.

Adults are expected to maintain control of minors at all times. Adults and minors are expected to adhere to the codes of conduct set forth by the College. Disruption of instructional activities will not be tolerated and the supervising adult will be subject to disciplinary action.

The President/Superintendent shall establish administrative procedures to define and regulate minors on campus. Visitors to any District facilities are subject to all relevant District policies and procedures.
