



TUBERCULOSIS (TB) TEST

You have five (5) options to complete your TB test requirements. They are:

1. If you have had a TB test done within the last 60 days, simply provide your physician's signed note.
2. If you have worked at another community college or school district, ask them to forward your results directly to us.
3. Go to Ohlone College's Student Health Center for your intradermal TB test. There is no fee for this service*. Please call (510) 659-6258. Testing available Monday, Tuesday, or Wednesday, by appointment only.
4. Go to Washington Township Medical Group for your intradermal TB test. There is no fee for this service*. Their phone number is (510) 651-2371. Testing available on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, and Friday.
5. Or, you may be tested by your private physician—at your own expense. You must return to the clinic or doctor's office and have the test read within 48 to 72 hours. Otherwise, you will need to be retested, at your own expense.

* **For positive TB test results:** you will be required to take a chest x-ray for medical evaluation and obtain written documentation that you are free from active tuberculosis. Use the Washington Township Medical Group or your own physician for this x-ray. The District does not cover this cost. If you are unable to show freedom from active TB, you will not be hired or rehired.
