Do NOT drop classes – You must not drop below 12 units or you will become “out-of-status” and your I-20 may be terminated. You must continue to be enrolled in 12 units, even if you think you are failing classes. You must also continue to attend class so that your instructors will not drop you. If you are having problems with a class please talk with the instructor, with Counselor Mandy Yip or staff in the Office of International Programs and Services.

Are you traveling this summer?

If you are traveling be sure your passport is current. You will need to have your I-20 signed on page 3 (within the last year). Please bring it in at least one week before your departure date. If you are traveling abroad and your visa is expiring you will need to renew it before you return to the United States. Have a great summer!



Registration for Fall 2008. You should have received your Registration Appointment email. You can register on or after the date listed. Do not wait too long to register as popular classes fill quickly. You should pay your fees before the start of the Fall Semester. If you wish to set up a payment plan you can make arrangements with the Cashier to do that. You will be blocked from sending transcripts, or registering for the next term if you have not paid your fees.

ELI students. You may have received a Registration Appointment. However you cannot register for Summer and Fall until you have completed your classes, progressed from the ELI and met with Counselor Mandy Yip.



See a counselor. It is good to make an early appointment to see a counselor to be sure you are on track with your graduation and transfer requirements. Counselor Mandy Yip works with international students, although you may see any counselor.
