FINANCIAL AFFIDAVIT

International students are required to provide documentation of financial support before a Form I-20 can be issued to them by Ohlone College. Documentation of financial support includes 2 items: 1) this completed Financial Affidavit form, and 2) an official bank statement. **Please submit BOTH of these items as part of the application.**

SELF-SUPPORTING STUDENTS: If the student will use his/her own personal funds as the source of financial support, the student **must provide and official bank statement** showing the availability of at least \$19,294 in liquid assets, **and** complete the Statement of Financial Obligation below. ELI students must demonstrate \$23,681 in liquid assets.

STUDENTS SUPPORTED BY A FINANCIAL GUARANTOR: If someone else will financially support the student (examples: family member, friend, or private institution,) the Financial Guarantor **must provide their official bank statement** showing the availability of at least \$19,294 in liquid assets, **and** complete the Statement of Financial Obligation below. ELI students must demonstrate \$23,681 in liquid assets.
