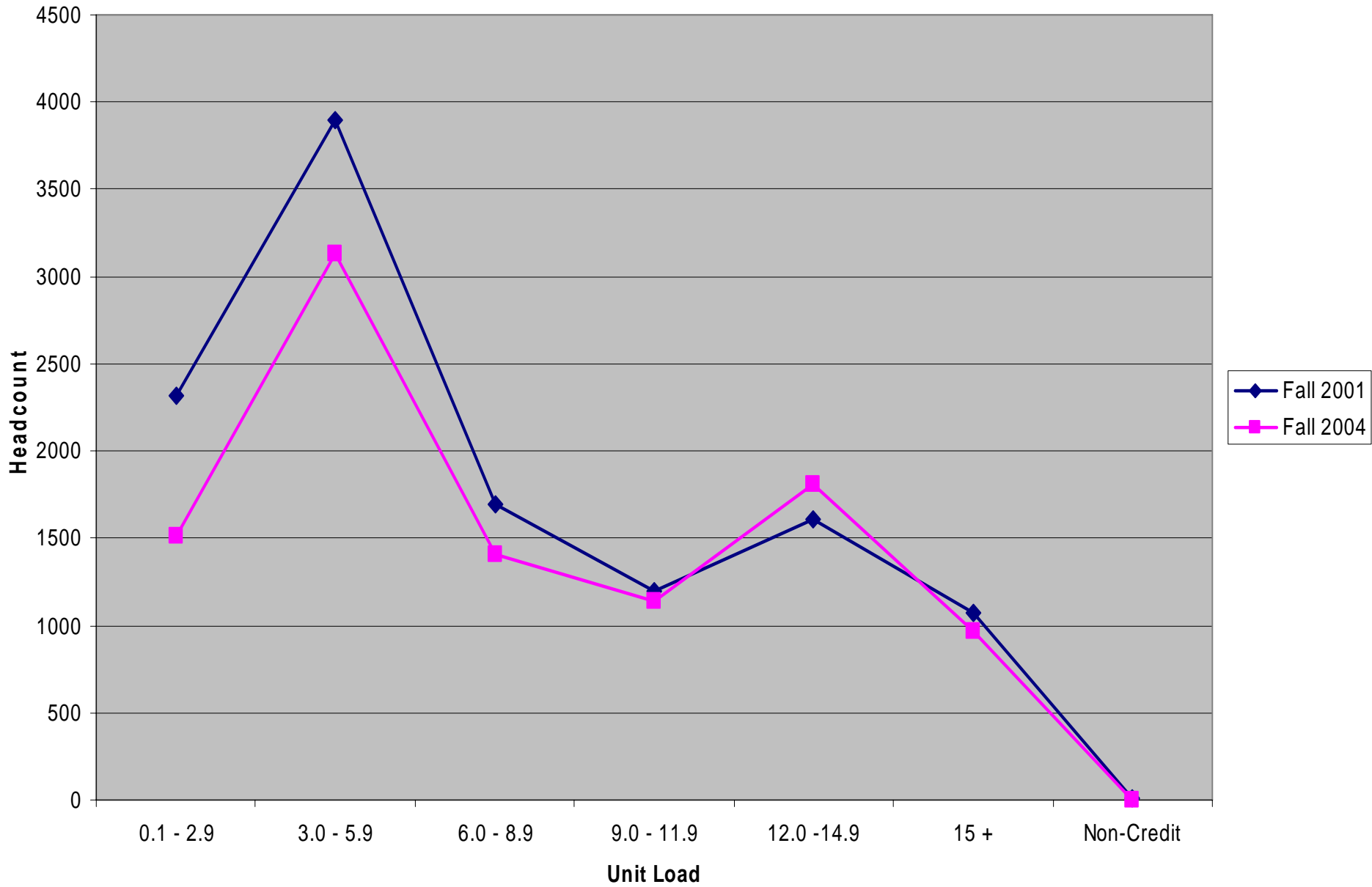

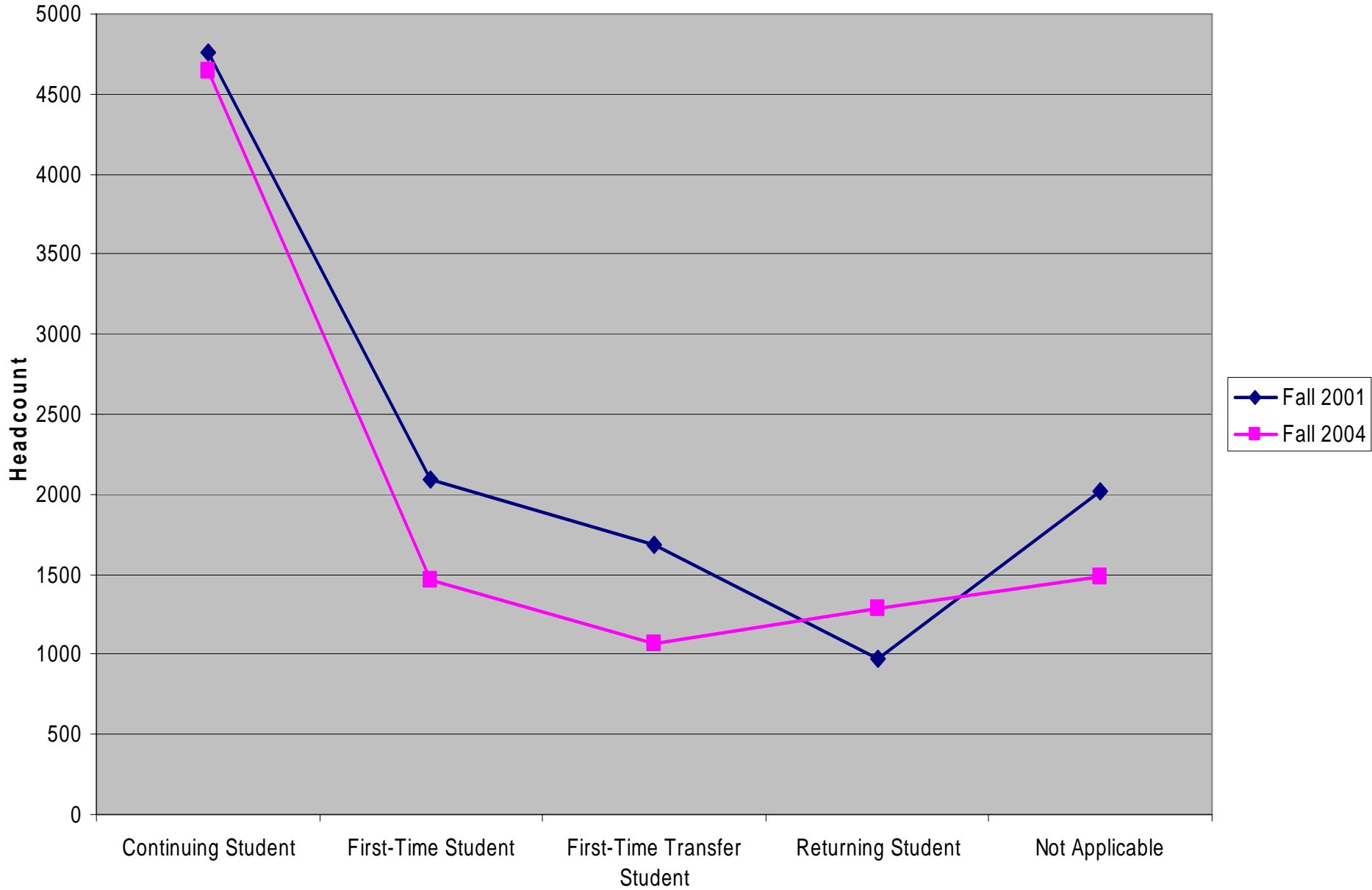

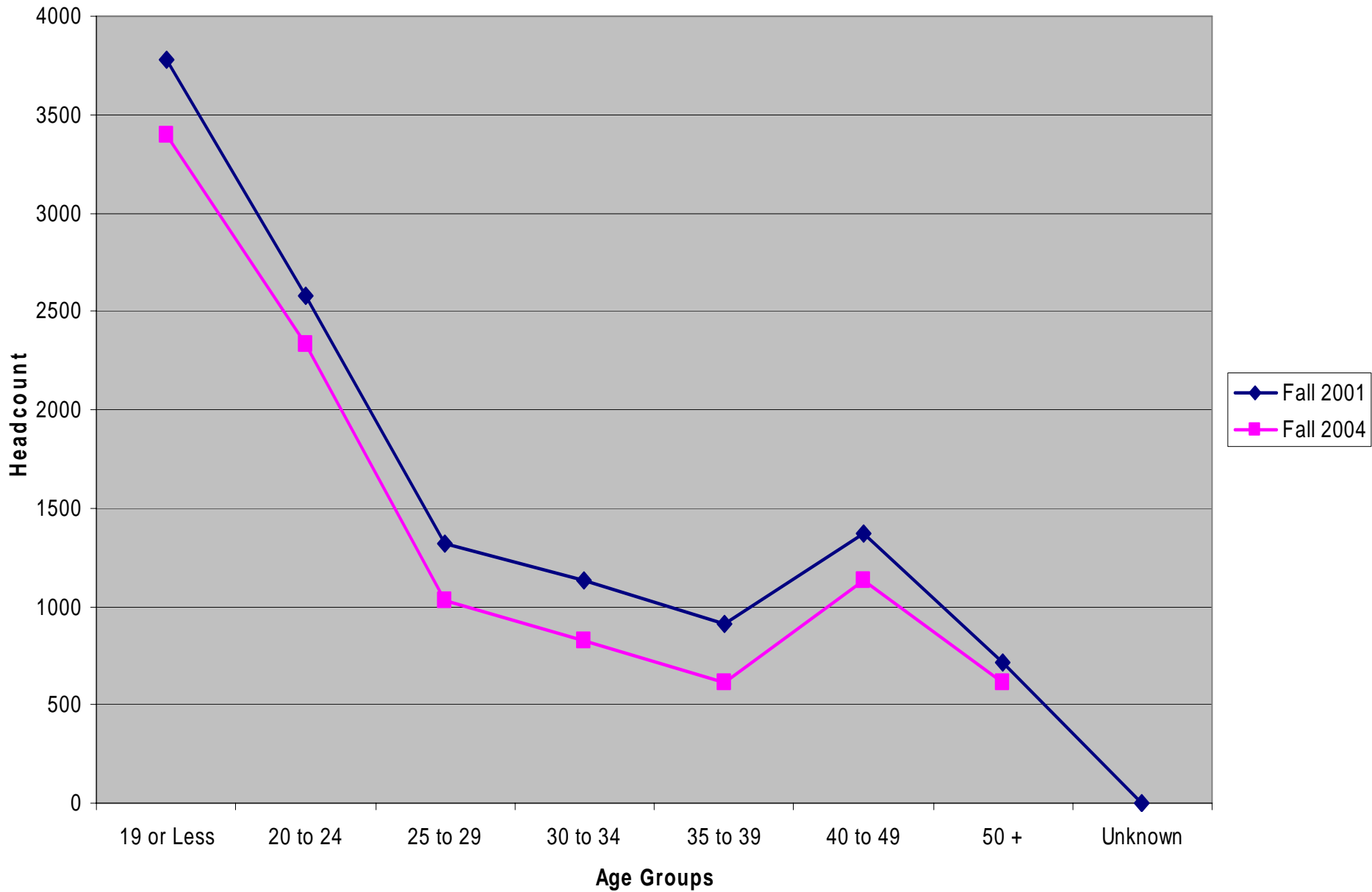
# Fall Headcounts by Unit Load
