HISTORY:

CCCSAT is a statewide, grant-funded initiative established by the California Community College Chancellor's Office in 1997 to advance distance learning and support the mission of the California Community College system. CCCSAT is based at Palomar College in San Marcos, California.

DESCRIPTION:

The California Community Colleges Satellite Network is your gateway to a world of free, informative and educational satellite and Web-based programming for CCC faculty, staff and students.

CCCSAT is the California Community Colleges Satellite Network and provides diverse television programming resources for instruction and professional development, and also includes original student-produced programs and news from the CCC campuses.

CCCSAT programming can be accessed on campus through the digital satellite receive site located at each campus or simply by clicking on our website at www.cccsat.org and viewing the program via live Web-cast.

CCCSAT operates two broadcast television channels, which distribute over 500 hours per month of a variety of relevant CCC programming, student productions and professional development/training opportunities direct to your campus via satellite or to your desktop via the World Wide Web.

Programming focus hours include Health, Technology, Arts, Professional Development, Culture and Diversity, CCC News and student produced programs.
