## PROGRAM MANAGEMENT:

- Bureau of Automotive Repair program provides specialized smog checks for special vehicles on 33 community college sites.
- Betty Moore Nursing Initiative is a four million grant for the development of a centralized clinical placement.
- FUSION is a system-wide database for Facilities Condition Assessment for 109 California Community Colleges.

## GRANT MANAGEMENT:

### Gates Foundation:

- Early College High School (ECHS) Initiative is to improve the high school and college graduation rates of students, especially students who historically have had lower than average high school and college graduation rates.
- The Initiative is assisting in the establishment of fifteen grade 9-12 Early College High Schools on or near California community college campuses.

- **Microsoft Campus Agreement:** Broad software license agreement.
- **Competitive Bids:** for Live Captioning Services, Office Supplies, Furniture and Technology.
- **LACCD Bonds:** FCCC will process all orders on the contracts awarded for LACCD FFE of \$2.4 million Bond program. This bond can be used by all public entities including community colleges. The first contract is for furniture and is available now.
- **Student Employment:** The Foundation for California Community Colleges hires students from accredited colleges and universities to work at certain California State agencies under the Student Assistant Services of California program.
- **Financial Services:** FCCC provides the following financial services for community colleges such as collection and dissemination of funds, financial record keeping and reporting, audited financial statements and hiring of temporary staff.
