William S. Bickard Memorial
Scholarship

Application Deadline: April 18, 2008

Funds: One (1) \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to a currently enrolled Ohlone College student. \$500 will be paid in Fall 2008. Another \$500 will be paid in Spring 2009 if student continues to satisfy criteria points 1-3 (see below).

Scholarship Criteria:

1. Enrolled at Ohlone College with a minimum of 9 semester units.
2. Student must be interested in pursuing a career in the insurance or business field.
3. Student must have a cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.0 or better.
4. Student must have completed at least 20 units, but no more than 70 units.

Required Documents:

In order to be considered for an Ohlone College Scholarship, all applicants must:

- Submit a completed Ohlone College scholarship application. Applications may be retrieved from the web site: <http://scholarships.ohlone.edu>.
- Applications must be submitted on or before the submission deadline. Late applications will not be accepted
- Two letters of recommendation
- Students will be asked to write a thank you letter to the donor before a check will be issued.

Eligibility Checklist

*This checklist **MUST** be filled out and attached with your Ohlone College Foundation scholarship application in order to be considered. If you do not meet any one of the below criteria, your application will **NOT** be considered.*

- I am taking at least 9 units at Ohlone College
- I am interested in pursuing a career in the insurance or business field.
- My cumulative Grade Point Average at Ohlone College is at least 3.0
- I have completed at least 20 semester units, but less than 70 units

*If you have met all the above requirements, make sure that the below documents are submitted in addition to your scholarship application and personal statement. If any of the below documents are not included, your application will **NOT** be considered.*

- Unofficial copy of college transcript
- Copy of current semester registration (WebAdvisor printout showing current classes)
- Two letters of recommendation
