**Ward Blanchard Memorial Scholarship**

**Application Deadline: April 18, 2008**

**Funds:** One (1) \$500 scholarships will be given to an Ohlone College student in memory of Ward Blanchard, former Director of Library Services at Ohlone College.

**Scholarship Criteria:**

1. Student must be enrolled in 12 college units or more.
2. Student must have a cumulative Grade Point Average of 3.0 or better
3. Transferring or continuing student.
4. Has completed 13.0 units or more.
5. No major preference.

**Required Documents:**

In order to be considered for an Ohlone College Scholarship, all applicants must:

- Submit a completed Ohlone College scholarship application. Applications may be retrieved from the web site: <http://scholarships.ohlone.edu>.
- Applications must be submitted on or before the submission deadline. Late applications will not be accepted.
- Two current letters of recommendation (obtained from previous employers, past or present instructors, etc.)
- Students will be asked to write a thank you letter to the donor before a check will be issued.

## Eligibility Checklist

***This checklist MUST be filled out and attached with your Ohlone College Foundation scholarship application in order to be considered. If you do not meet any one of the below criteria, your application will NOT be considered.***

- I am taking at least 12 units at Ohlone College
- My cumulative Grade Point Average at Ohlone College is at least 3.0
- I am a transferring or continuing student
- I have completed 13 units or more

***If you have met all the above requirements, make sure that the below documents are submitted in addition to your scholarship application and personal statement. If any of the below documents are not included, your application will NOT be considered.***

- Unofficial copy of college transcript
- Copy of current semester registration (WebAdvisor printout showing current classes)
- Two letters of recommendation obtained from previous employers, past or present instructors, etc.
