Application Deadline: April 18, 2008

Funds: Two (2) \$500 scholarships will be awarded.

Scholarship Criteria:

1. Must be a first generation (neither parent attended college) college student with a family.
2. Student must demonstrate need through FAFSA processing with Financial Aid office
3. Student must be enrolled in at least 6 units at Ohlone College
4. Student must be employed at least 15 hours a week
5. Student must have a cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.5 or better.

Required Documents:

In order to be considered for an Ohlone College Scholarship, all applicants must:

- Applicants must submit a completed scholarship application and submit a one page personal statement about what a college education will mean in their life. The statement should be printed on a computer or typewriter, double-spaced with 12 pt font.
- Applications must be submitted on or before the submission deadline. Late applications will not be accepted
- Students will be asked to write a thank you letter to the donor before a check will be issued.

Eligibility Checklist

This checklist MUST be filled out and attached with your Ohlone College Foundation scholarship application in order to be considered. If you do not meet any one of the below criteria, your application will NOT be considered.

- I am a first generation (neither parent attended college) college student with a family.
- I have financial need demonstrated through FAFSA processing with Financial Aid office
- I am enrolled in at least 6 units at Ohlone College.
- I am employed for at least 15 hours a week
- I have a cumulative Grade Point Average of at least 2.5 at Ohlone College.

If you have met all the above requirements, make sure that the below documents are submitted in addition to your scholarship application and personal statement. If any of the below documents are not included, your application will NOT be considered.

- A typewritten personal statement about what college will mean in your life, double-spaced in 12 point font.
- Unofficial copy of college transcript
- Copy of current semester registration (WebAdvisor printout showing current classes)
- On a separate typewritten sheet, list the name of employer(s) and their contact information.
