

# Ohlone College Foundation 2008 Scholarship Announcement

## Carol E. Goodell Memorial Scholarship

**Application Deadline: April 18, 2008**

**Funds:** Two (2) \$500 scholarships will be offered. The purpose of the scholarship fund will be to provide an annual scholarship for a Deaf female student attending Ohlone College and who is enrolled in Deaf Studies classes. The fund will provide the scholarship to help lower costs of attendance, including enrollment fees, books, housing and related expenses.

### **Scholarship Criteria:**

1. Be a US citizen or an eligible non-citizen.

An eligible non-citizen is a permanent US resident who has documentation, such as an I-94, I-151, I-688 or I-551 (Alien Registration Receipt) from the US Citizenship and Immigration Service (formerly INS) verifying that your stay in the US is for other than a temporary purpose.

2. Be enrolled in at least 12 credits for this semester.
3. Student must have a cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.5 or better.
4. Has not been a previous recipient of the Carol E. Goodell Memorial Scholarship.
5. Is not the recipient of any other scholarships for this semester.

### **Required Documents:**

In order to be considered for an Ohlone College Scholarship, all applicants must:

- Submit a completed Ohlone College scholarship application.
- Applications must be submitted on or before the submission deadline. Late applications will not be accepted.
- An essay on why you need the scholarship by writing a statement of 75 to 100 words.
- Students will be asked to write a thank you letter to the donor before a check will be issued.

# Carol E. Goodell Memorial Scholarship

## Eligibility Checklist

***This checklist MUST be filled out and attached with your Ohlone College Foundation scholarship application in order to be considered. If you do not meet any one of the below criteria, your application will NOT be considered.***

- I am a deaf student.
- I am female.
- I am a US citizen or an eligible non-citizen.  
(An eligible non-citizen is a permanent US resident who has documentation, such as an I-94, I-151, I-688 or I-551 (Alien Registration Receipt) from the US Citizenship and Immigration Service (formerly INS) verifying that your stay in the US is for other than a temporary purpose.)
- I am enrolled in at least 12 units this semester.
- My Grade Point Average at Ohlone College is 2.5 or better. (For first year students, your high school GPA can be used instead).
- I have not previously been awarded the Carol E. Goodell Memorial Scholarship.
- I am not receiving any other scholarships this semester.

***If you have met all the above requirements, make sure that the below documents are submitted in addition to your scholarship application and personal statement. If any of the below documents are not included, your application will NOT be considered.***

- A statement of why you need this scholarship in 75 to 100 words..
- Unofficial copy of college transcript
- Copy of current semester registration (WebAdvisor printout showing current classes)
