

Ohlone Community College District Parking Regulations and Policy

There is No Free Parking at any of the Ohlone Community College District Campuses

Fremont Campus

Daily Parking Permits

Daily Parking Permits allow student and visitors to park in Lots C, D, E, G, H, K, and M. Daily Parking Permits are valid only at the campus where purchased. There are vending machines located in the general parking lots. Students may purchase a Daily Parking Permit and park in Lot M. Lot N is restricted to ASOC, Carpool, Disabled parking, and coin operated meter parking. Lots O and P are currently closed due to construction of the new Student Services Building.

Semester Parking Permits

Student Semester Parking Permits allow students to park in Lots C, D, E, G, H, and K. A Semester Parking Permit is not valid to park in any of the upper parking lots M, N, O, or P. Students may purchase a Daily Parking Permit and park in Lot M. Lot N is restricted to ASOC, Carpool, Disabled parking, and coin operated meter parking. Lots O and P are currently closed due to construction of the new Student Services Building.

Semester Parking Permits are valid for both the Fremont and Newark campus.

Staff Lot B

Students or visitors may park in Staff Lot B, next to Hyman Hall, after 5:00 pm Mondays through Fridays and on Saturdays. Students must display a valid Semester Parking Permit or a valid Daily Parking Permit. Visitors must display a valid Daily Parking Permit.

Metered Parking

Coin operated metered parking is available in Lots M and N as a convenience and courtesy. The coin operated meters are for one (1) hour parking. The cost is \$0.25 per fifteen minutes. The coin operated meters will accept nickels, dimes, and quarters in any combination up to sixty (60) minutes maximum. Any excess beyond \$1.00 or 60 minutes is not recorded and the coin operated machines do not give change for amounts over \$1.00.

Newark Center HST Campus

Daily Parking Permits allow students to park anywhere in Lots A, B, C, or D except those spaces designated as Administration or Police/Emergency. Daily Parking Permits are valid only at the campus where purchased.

Semester Parking Permits allow students to park anywhere in Lots A, B, C, or D except those spaces designated as Administration or Police/Emergency.

Semester Parking Permits are valid for both the Fremont and Newark campus.

Administration and Police/Emergency Marked Spaces

Students and visitors may not park in spaces designated Administration without authorization.

Guest/Visitor Parking

Guests or visitors must have a Guest Parking Permit or a Temporary Parking Permit that designates where they may park or must purchase a Daily Parking Permit. There is No Free Parking at either campus for guests or visitors unless the guest or visitor is issued a Guest or Temporary Parking Permit.

Guest or Temporary Parking Permits may be requested at Campus Police Services.

Curfew

The Fremont and Newark campuses are closed between 11:00pm and 6:00am. No overnight parking is allowed except upon prior approval from Campus Police Services.

Parking Enforcement

Parking is enforced at both campuses Monday through Friday from 7:00am to 11:00 pm and Saturdays 7:00am to 5:00pm. Parking is currently free on Sundays and Holidays, and is subject to change.

Disabled, Staff, Emergency and Fire Lane, Visitor designated parking, and other special or specifically designated parking is enforced 7 days per week.
