

Course and/or Program Student Learning Outcome Assessment (SLOA)

Planning and Documentation Worksheet

- Faculty may find this worksheet helpful in organizing and implementing Course and/or Program SLOA activities.
- The steps correlate with the Course and/or Program SLOA pages in the CurricUNET Program Review Module.
- Once the SLOA activity is underway or finished, it should be easy to transfer the work to CurricUNET.

1. Review and have dialogue about the Course and/or Program SLOs and revise if needed.
2. Chose Course and/or Program SLO(s) to be assessed.
3. Chose an assessment strategy or tool that addresses the SLO(s).

Examples: Rubrics, Portfolio, Culminating project, Performance assessment, Department testing, Placement tests used for course entry and exit decisions, Vendor or industry certification examination, Indirect Assessment: Survey, Focus Group Discussion, Interview, or others....

Try to use assessment strategies you are already using to evaluate student work as part of your grading system.

4. Describe your results or findings.
5. Describe and faculty dialogue involved in the assessment process.
6. Based on an analysis of your findings and dialogue, describe revisions, if any, in curriculum or teaching strategies implemented to promote student success.
7. If improvements are implemented, describe the results.
