

## Assessment for Online Student Success Workshops!

I have completed the creation of our online Student Success Workshops!

Student Success Workshops are recommended for students who have a GPA below a 2.0 and/or more "W", "I", "NC" grades than passing grades. However, if students are on probation for more than one semester they are then mandated to attend a Student Success Workshop. In the past these workshops have been offered on a rotating basis on campus. However, there are always students who cannot attend during the days/times we offer them and/or would like to attend more than one of the workshops. So, having these workshops online is going to be of great benefit to our students!

After much deliberation, trial and error I decided to create two of the seven workshops directly on the Ohlone College/Counseling webpage for students to go through at their leisure. Students can now access the "Why Am I On Probation?" and "All About Progress Probation" online via the counseling webpage.

Working with the online education department I was able to create the other five workshops using WebCT. So, from the same website mentioned above students can now request a WebCT account to access any/all of the other five workshops. I felt the content of these workshops was better accounted for using a password protected environment instead of opening it up to everyone via the world wide web.

We will be piloting the success of these workshops over the summer months and making any adjustments necessary before Fall.

Having these workshops available to students online will allow us to reach more students on probation and adjust our program to require these workshops of more students.
