UC/CC Concurrent Enrollment Restricted Courses
EFFECTIVE Spring 2011

The following courses are not open to students enrolled in the UC/CC Concurrent Enrollment Program. Enrollment in these courses will not be approved under any circumstances. These courses are restricted because they are over enrolled, or they are restricted at the request of the department. There are no exceptions to these restrictions and there is no appeal. This is the College's policy and not under the purview of the course instructor. The purpose of the program is to allow community college students the opportunity to experience Berkeley course work and the campus by taking lower a division course that is not otherwise available at the community colleges. All courses must be taken for a letter grade.

Please note: language courses that have labs charge a lab fee.

The restricted courses are:

Any course with an R prefix e.g. Scandinavian R5A, English R1B
Any course with an AC suffix (e.g. Comparative Literature 60AC)
Except AC courses in the Ethnic Studies dept.
Any course numbered 24, 39A-Z or 84
Any course numbered 97 or **higher** e.g. 98, 99, 101, 120, etc.
Any course offered **only** on a P/PN basis
